This firm is counsel to Norstan Apparel Shops, Inc. and Norstan Delaware Corp. (collectively, the "<u>Debtors</u>"). This letter advises the Court of the Debtors' resolution of all outstanding claim objections. As of today, the only claim objections that have not been resolved to final order are (i) the claim of Sweet Crush (no. 333) from the Debtors' Third Omnibus Objection to Claims (Claims to Be Reclassified); (ii) the claim of Ashland Industries, Inc. (no. 603) which is also from the Debtors' Third Omnibus Objection to Claims; and (iii) the claim of Pure Design, Inc.
