ORDER GRANTING FORTY-FOURTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO PROOFS OF CLAIM (NO BASIS CONSUMER CREDITOR ADMIN CLAIMS)

Upon the Forty-Fourth Omnibus Objection to Proofs of Claim (No Basis Consumer Creditor Admin Claims) filed on March 13, 2020 (the "Objection"),² for an order (i) disallowing and expunging the No Basis Consumer Creditor Admin Claims, and (ii) granting related relief, all as more fully set forth in the Objection; and the Bankruptcy Court having jurisdiction to consider the Objection and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157(a)-(b) and 1334 and the Amended Standing Order of Reference M-431, dated January 31, 2012 (Preska, C.J.); and consideration of the Objection and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and venue being proper before this Bankruptcy Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the relief requested in the Objection having been provided, and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided in accordance with the

The Debtors confirmed the *Third Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Ditech Holding Corporation and Its Affiliated Debtors* (ECF No. 1326) (the "**Third Amended Plan**"), which created the Wind Down Estates. Wind Down Estates, along with the last four digits of their federal tax identification number, as applicable, are Ditech Holding Corporation (0486); DF Insurance Agency LLC (6918); Ditech Financial LLC (5868); Green Tree Credit LLC (5864); Green Tree Credit Solutions LLC (1565); Green Tree Insurance Agency of Nevada, Inc. (7331); Green Tree Investment Holdings III LLC (1008); Green Tree Servicing Corp. (3552); Marix Servicing LLC (6101); Walter Management Holding Company LLC (9818); and Walter Reverse Acquisition LLC (8837). The Wind Down Estates' principal offices are located at 1100 Virginia Drive, Suite 100, Fort Washington, Pennsylvania 19034.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The Objection is granted to the extent set forth herein.
- 2. Each No Basis Consumer Creditor Admin Claim listed on **Exhibit 1** annexed to this Order is disallowed and expunged in its entirety from the claims register.
- 3. Each No Basis Consumer Creditor Admin Claim and the objections by the Plan Administrator to such Claims, as set forth on **Exhibit 1** hereto, constitutes a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014. This Order shall be deemed a separate Order with respect to each such No Basis Consumer Creditor Admin Claim. Any stay of this Order pending appeal by any Claimants whose claims are subject to this Order shall only apply to the contested matter which involves such Claimant and shall not act to stay the applicability and/or finality of this Order with respect to the other contested matters listed in the Objection or this Order.
- 4. This Order has no res judicata, estoppel, or other effect on the validity, allowance, or disallowance of, and all rights to object to or defend on any basis are expressly reserved with respect to any claim referenced or identified in the Objection that is not listed on **Exhibit 1**.
