ORDER LIMITING NOTICE

1 The Court has considered the Ex Parte Application For Order Limiting Notice (the
2 “Application”) of Debtors Clement Support Services, Inc. (“Clement”) and CSS Fabrication, Inc.
3 (“Fabrication”) filed herein. The Application being one which does not require a hearing and
4 being supported by the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors; and good cause appearing,

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

6 1. The Application is approved.

7 2. Notices required to be given pursuant to F.R.B.P. 2002(a)(2), (3) and (6), and any
8 other such notices as are required to be given with respect to the administration of this case,
9 exclusive of the notices contemplated in F.R.B.P. 2002(a)(1), (4), (5), (7), (8) and (b), be limited
10 to the following: (1) the Responsible Individual for each of the Debtors; (2) the Committee and
11 counsel for the Committee in the Clement case; (3) all creditors listed on Fabrication’s List of
12 Creditors Holding 20 Largest Unsecured Claims (until such time as there is a committee
13 appointed in the Fabrication case, at which time notice would be given to such committee and its
14 appointed counsel instead); (4) the Office of the United States Trustee in San Jose, California;
15 (5) parties affected by the particular motion; and (6) any party in interest who serves on Debtors’
16 counsel and files with the Court a request for special notice in either bankruptcy case.

17 3. Warrant Claimants shall not be required to receive any further notice in these
18 chapter 11 cases unless a Warranty Claimant (a) files a Proof of Claim and/or (b) files a request
19 for special notice in either bankruptcy case.
