# STIPULATION AND AGREED ORDER REGARDING PROOFS OF CLAIM NOS. 892 AND 898

The above-captioned reorganized debtors (before the effective date of their plan of reorganization, the "<u>Debtors</u>," and after the effective date of their plan of reorganization, the "<u>Reorganized Debtors</u>")<sup>2</sup> and Shell Energy North America (US), L.P. ("<u>SENA</u>," and together with the Reorganized Debtors, the "<u>Parties</u>") hereby enter into this stipulation and agreed order (this "Stipulation and Agreed Order") as follows:

WHEREAS, On January 15, 2018, each Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the "Bankruptcy Court");

The Reorganized Debtors in these chapter 11 cases, along with the last four digits of each Reorganized Debtor's federal tax identification number, include: EXCO Resources, Inc. (2779); EXCO GP Partners Old, LP (1262); EXCO Holdings (PA), Inc. (1745); EXCO Holding MLP, Inc. (1972); EXCO Land Company, LLC (9981); EXCO Midcontinent MLP, LLC (0557); EXCO Operating Company, LP (1261); EXCO Partners GP, LLC (1258); EXCO Partners OLP GP, LLC (1252); EXCO Production Company (PA), LLC (7701); EXCO Production Company (WV), LLC (7851); EXCO Resources (XA), LLC (7775); EXCO Services, Inc. (2747); Raider Marketing GP, LLC (6366); and Raider Marketing, LP (4295). The location of the Reorganized Debtors' service address is: 12377 Merit Drive, Suite 1700, Dallas, Texas 75251.

Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Order Confirming Third Amended Settlement Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization of EXCO Resources, Inc. and Its Debtor Affiliates [Docket No. 2128] (the "Confirmation Order") or the Third Amended Settlement Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization of EXCO Resources, Inc. And Its Debtor Affiliates [Docket No. 2103] (the "Plan"), as applicable.

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2018, SENA filed two proofs of claim: proof of claim number 898 ("Claim 898"), asserting a claim partially secured by setoff rights in the amount of \$45,750,202.85, against Debtor Raider Marketing, LP ("Raider"), and proof of claim number 892 ("Claim 892" and together with Claim 898, the "SENA Claims"), asserting a claim partially secured by setoff rights in the amount of \$45,750,202.85, against Debtor EXCO Operating Company, LP.

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2019, the Bankruptcy Court entered the Confirmation Order;

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2019, Reorganized Debtor Raider filed a demand for arbitration with the American Arbitration Association (the "<u>Arbitration</u>") relating to the adversary proceeding styled as EXCO Operating Co., LP v. Shell Energy North America (US) [Ad. Pro. No. 18-03015] (the "<u>EXCO v. SENA Proceeding</u>" and together with the SENA Claims, the "<u>SENA Dispute</u>");

WHEREAS, on December 24, 2019, the Reorganized Debtors filed a protective objection to the SENA Claims (the "Claim Objection") [Docket No. 276];

WHEREAS, the Parties participated in binding Arbitration before the American Arbitration Association with respect to the SENA Dispute;

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2021, the American Arbitration Association issued an award (the "Arbitration Award") with respect to the SENA Dispute, which Arbitration Award was supplemented on May 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now seek to liquidate the SENA Claims pursuant to the Arbitration Award and the Plan.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS STIPULATED AND AGREED as follows:

- 1. Claim 892 is hereby reduced in amount to \$13,624,509.91 and Allowed as a General Unsecured Claim in such amount, representing: (a) \$10,060,024.26 in net damages owed by Raider to SENA; (b) \$2,312,945.65 in contractual interest against Raider associated with the foregoing damages at a rate of 7.31 percent per annum from March 5, 2018 to April 26, 2021; (c) \$51,452.12 in contractual interest against Raider in post-judgment interest at a rate of 7.31 percent per annum from April 27, 2021 until the date of filing this Stipulation and Agreed Order; and (d) \$1,200,087.88 in SENA's attorneys' fees and costs related to the Arbitration.
  - 2. Claim 898 is hereby disallowed in its entirety.
  - 3. The Claim Objection is deemed withdrawn.
- 4. With the exception of the right to receive a distribution on account of its Allowed General Unsecured Claim, SENA, for itself and on behalf of its predecessors, successors, affiliates, assigns, agents, representatives, and professionals, fully, finally, and forever releases, relinquishes and discharges the Debtors, the Reorganized Debtors, and the Reorganized Debtors' predecessors, successors, assigns, agents, representatives, and professionals, from all rights, claims, demands, damages of any kind, and causes of action of every nature, whether known or unknown, asserted or unasserted, arising prior to the date hereof or related to the subject matter of the SENA Dispute.
- 5. Raider, for itself and on behalf of its predecessors, successors, affiliates, assigns, agents, representatives, and professionals, fully, finally, and forever releases, relinquishes and discharges SENA, and SENA's predecessors, successors, assigns, agents, representatives, and professionals, from all rights, claims, demands, damages of any kind, and causes of action of every nature, whether known or unknown, asserted or unasserted, arising prior to the date hereof or related to the subject matter of the SENA Dispute.

6. This Stipulation and Agreed Order contains the entire agreement between the

Parties as to its subject matter and supersedes any and all prior agreements and undertakings

between the Parties relating thereto.

7. The Reorganized Debtors are authorized to take any and all actions reasonably

necessary or appropriate to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Stipulation and Agreed

Order.

8. Epiq Corporate Restructuring, LLC is hereby authorized and directed to update the

official claims register to reflect the relief granted by this Stipulation and Agreed Order.

9. The Bankruptcy Court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters

arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Stipulation

and Agreed Order.
