Crime-Fraud Exception and/or Waiver of the Attorney Client Privilege and Work Product

Protection (the "Crime Fraud Motion"); and (3) Informational Brief of the Official Committee of

Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants of DBMP LLC (the "Informational Brief") that will exceed

the 25-page limit established by Rule 9013-2(a) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the
