**ORDER DENYING MOTION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF
ASBESTOS PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMANTS AND THE FUTURE
CLAIMANTS' REPRESENTATIVE TO COMPEL THE DEBTOR TO PRODUCE
ALL SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS WITHHELD ON THE BASIS OF
PRIVILEGE OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO PRECLUDE THE DEBTOR
FROM SELECTIVELY OFFERING EVIDENCE IN SUPPORT OF
THE TRUST DISCOVERY MOTION**

This matter coming before the Court on the *Motion to Compel the Debtor to Produce All Settlement Documents Withheld on the Basis of Privilege or, in the Alternative, to Preclude the Debtor from Selectively Offering Evidence in Support of the Trust Discovery Motion* (Dkt. 1019) (the "Motion") filed by the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants and the Future Claimants' Representative (together, the "Movants"), the Debtor's objection to the Motion (Dkt. 1039) (the "Objection"), and the Movants' reply in support of the Motion (Dkt. 1044) (the "Reply"); the Court having

reviewed the Motion, the Objection, and the Reply and having heard the arguments of counsel with respect to the Motion at the hearing on September 17, 2021 (the “Hearing”);

1. The Motion is DENIED without prejudice for the reasons stated by the Court on the record at the hearing (which is incorporated herein).
2. This Court retains exclusive jurisdiction over this Order and any and all matters arising from or relating to the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.
