**ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF INTEGRITY EXPRESS LOGISTICS, LLC FOR
ALLOWANCE AND PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE CLAIM

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


