THIRD ORDER EXTENDING THE CLAIMS OBJECTION DEADLINE

Upon consideration of the motion (the “Motion”) of Anthony M. Saccullo, in his capacity as liquidating trustee (the “Liquidating Trustee”) of the FI Liquidating Trust (the “Trust”), by and through his undersigned counsel, on behalf of the estates of the above captioned debtors (the “Debtors”), for entry of an order, pursuant to Sections 105(a) and 502 of the Bankruptcy Code,² Rules 3007 and 9006 of the Bankruptcy Rules, and the authority granted in paragraph 21 of the Confirmation Order and Article IX.F. of the Plan, extending the Claims Objection Deadline through and including April 11, 2022, and the Court having reviewed the Motion; the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and (c) due and sufficient notice of the Motion has been given; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Claims Objection Deadline shall be, and hereby is, extended through and including April 11, 2022.
3. This Order is without prejudice to the rights of the Liquidating Trustee to seek further extensions of the Claims Objection Deadline upon motion filed with the Court.
4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over all matters arising from or related to the implementation and interpretation of this Order.
