- 4. To the extent not already paid, the fees required to be paid to the United States Trustee pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1930(a)(6) shall be paid within 30 days after the date of entry of this Final Decree and Order.
- 5. Notwithstanding any stay that might be applicable to this Final Decree and Order, this Final Decree and Order shall be effective and enforceable immediately upon entry hereof.

6. Pursuant to Local Rule 2002-1(f), Epiq is relieved of any further obligations with

respect to claims and noticing services effective immediately upon entry of this Final Decree and

Order. In accordance with Local Rule 2002-l(f)(ix), within twenty-eight (28) days of entry of this

Final Decree and Order, Epiq will: (a) forward to the Clerk an electronic version of all imaged

claims, (b) upload the creditor mailing list into CM/ECF, and (c) docket a Final Claims Register.

Epiq shall further box and transport all original claims to the Philadelphia Federal Records Center,

14470 Townsend Road, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19154 and docket a completed SF-135 Form

indicating the accession and location numbers of the archived claims.

7. Entry of this Final Decree and Order shall be without prejudice to the rights of a

party-in-interest to seek to reopen the Chapter 11 Case for cause.

8. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to construe and enforce the terms of the Motion

and this Final Decree and Order.
