

ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART MOTION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF ASBESTOS PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMANTS AND THE FUTURE CLAIMANTS' REPRESENTATIVE FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER (I) GRANTING LEAVE, STANDING, AND AUTHORITY TO INVESTIGATE, COMMENCE, PROSECUTE, AND TO SETTLE CERTAIN CAUSES OF ACTION, AND (II) TO CONDUCT RELEVANT EXAMINATIONS

This matter having come before the Court on the Motion of the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants and the Future Claimants' Representative for Entry of an Order (I) Granting Leave, Standing, and Authority to Investigate, Commence, Prosecute, and to Settle Certain Causes of Action, and (II) to Conduct Relevant Examinations [ECF No. 1008] (the "Motion"), dated August 23, 2021, the Debtor's opposition to the Motion dated September 23, 2021 [ECF No. 1072] (the "Objection"), the joinder of CertainTeed LLC and Saint-Gobain Corporation to the Debtor's opposition to the Motion dated September 23, 2021 [ECF No. 1074] (the "Joinder"), the reply of the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants and the Future Claimants' Representative in further support of the Motion dated September 30, 2021 [ECF

No. 1085] (the "Reply"); the Court having reviewed the Motion, the Objection, the Joinder in the Objection and the Reply, and having heard the arguments and submissions of counsel presented at the hearing on October 5, 2021 and for the reasons announced by the Court on October 14, 2021;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants and the Future Claimants' Representative are granted standing and authority to prosecute and, if appropriate and approved by the Court after notice and hearing, settle claims on behalf of the Debtor's estate, with respect to, arising from or otherwise related to the Corporate Restructuring (as defined in the Motion).
- 2. The portion of the Motion requesting relief under Local Rule 2004-1 and Bankruptcy Rule 2004 to issue subpoenas without further authority of the Court is denied.
- 3. This Court retains exclusive jurisdiction over this Order and any and all matters arising from or relating to the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.
