("<u>Osceola</u>"), for entry of an order allowing and compelling payment of administrative expense claim pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(9), as more fully described in the Motion; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Motion and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and venue being proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the Motion having been provided, and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and all of the proceedings had before the Court; and the Court having found and determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is

ORDERED that the Motion is granted as set forth herein; and it is further

ORDERED that Osceola is allowed a claim in the amount of \$7,467.35 as an administrative expense of the estate pursuant to Section 503(b)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code; and it is further

ORDERED that Osceola is also allowed a claim in the amount of \$69,349.96 as an administrative expense of the estate pursuant to Section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors shall immediately, and by no later than December 4, 2021, remit the sum of \$7,467.35 to Osceola; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors shall also pay \$69,349.96 to Osceola in accordance with the following payment schedule: (i) \$20,804.99 to be paid on or before December 15, 2021; (ii) \$20,804.99 to be paid on ore before January 15, 2022; and (iii) \$27,739.98 to be paid on or before February 15, 2022; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the implementation and/or interpretation of this Order.
