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ORDER SCHEDULING HEARING

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2020, the Consumer Claims Trustee and Plan Administrator filed the *Objection of the Consumer Claims Trustee and the Plan Administrator to Claim No. 21367 of Stella Johnson, Bernadette Martinez & Monique J. Scranton; Reply to Response to Omnibus Objection to Related Claim Nos. 60195, 1745, 1797, 2502, 60239, 2552, 2559, 2574, 2630, 21622* [ECF No. 2324] (the “Claim Objection”); and

WHEREAS, on May 31, 2020 counsel for creditors Monique Scranton, Stella Johnson, Bernadette Martinez, (the “Class Representatives”) filed the *Motion by Monique Scranton, Stella Johnson, Bernadette Martinez, Individually and as Representative Claimants for 800 Consumer Creditors, Seeking Orders pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7023 Certifying them as a Class and Authorizing Their Prosecuting Their Class Proof of Claim as a Class Action With Point Authorities* [ECF No. 2438] (the “Class Certification Motion”); and

WHEREAS, the Court adjourned the hearings on the Claim Objection and Class Certification Motion; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2021, counsel for the Class Representatives filed the response on behalf of approximately 800 class members [ECF No. 3531]; and

WHEREAS, on November 23, 2021, the Consumer Claims Trustee and Plan Administrator filed their reply [ECF No. 3781]; and

WHEREAS, the Claim Objection is fully briefed and briefing is closed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS:

ORDERED that the Claim Objection and Class Certification Motion shall be heard on January 20, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. (ET); and

ORDERED that the response to the Class Certification Motion shall be filed and served on or before December 10, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. (ET); and

ORDERED that replies, if any, shall be filed and served no later than December 16, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. (ET); and

ORDERED that parties shall provide the Court with two, single sided hard copies of all filings in advance of the hearing.
