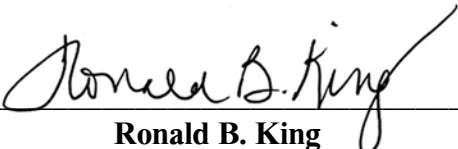

**ORDER GRANTING FOURTH INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF GRAVES
DOUGHERTY HEARON & MOODY, PC AS COUNSEL FOR THE ESTATES**

CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION the *Third Interim Fee Application of Graves Dougherty Hearon & Moody, PC as Counsel for the Estates* [Dkt. No. 1326] (the “Application”) filed by Graves Dougherty Hearon & Moody, PC (“GDHM”) in connection with their representation of James Studensky, the duly appointed and acting trustee in the above-captioned

bankruptcy cases (the “Trustee”). After considering the Application and any responses thereto, the Court is of the opinion that it should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the total amount of \$527,227.93 in fees billed and expenses incurred by GDHM in the representation of the Trustee from November 1, 2020 through October 31, 2021 (the “Application Period”) is hereby APPROVED on an interim basis.

IT IS, FURTHERMORE, ORDERED that GDHM is entitled to receive from the Trustee, and the Trustee is authorized to pay to GDHM, the balance of \$92,670.20 out of a total of \$527,227.93 in fees and expenses incurred during the Application Period, with credit given for the 434,557.73 in payments already made to GDHM in accordance with the Interim Compensation Procedures.

IT IS, FURTHERMORE, ORDERED that all fees and expenses paid to GDHM remain subject to disgorgement by future order of the Court in accordance with the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code and other governing law.
