**DEBTORS': (A) SECOND MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE
DEBTORS TO INCUR ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH
SERVICE AND NOTICING OF PLEADINGS; AND (B) MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER
AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS TO REIMBURSE ACTUAL INCURRED LEGAL EXPENSES
NUNC PRO TUNC TO PETITION DATE**

COMPREHENSIVE CLINICAL DEVELOPMENT, INC. and COMPREHENSIVE CLINICAL DEVELOPMENT, NW, INC. (collectively, the “Debtors”), by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully move this Court for the entry of an order authorizing the Debtors and/or their counsel Ehrenstein Charbonneau Calderin (“ECC”) to incur administrative expenses related to service and noticing in these jointly administered cases as well as authorizing the Debtors to reimburse ECC for actual incurred legal expenses *nunc pro tunc* to Petition Date (the “Motion”). In support of this Motion, the Debtors respectfully state as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

1. This Court has jurisdiction over this Motion under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157(b) and 1334. Venue is proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.
2. This is a core proceeding as defined in 28 U.S.C. § 157(b).

II. BACKGROUND

3. On March 29, 2013, the Debtors commenced their respective bankruptcy proceedings by filing voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.

4. On April 8, 2013 the Court entered the *Order Granting Debtors' Motion for Joint Administration* [ECF# 50], jointly administering the Debtors' cases under the lead case, *In re: Comprehensive Clinical Development, Inc.*, Case No.: 13-17273-JKO.

5. The Debtors are operating their businesses and managing their affairs as debtors-in-possession pursuant to section 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. No trustee or examiner has been appointed in these cases.

6. On April 15, 2013, the Office of the United States Trustee (the “UST”) filed its *Appointment and Notice of Appointment of Joint Committee of Creditors Holding Unsecured Claims* [ECF# 69] (the “Committee”).

7. For a more thorough account of the Debtors’ organizational background, business operations, and the events precipitating these Chapter 11 filings, the Debtors respectfully refer the Court to the *Declaration of Mr. James D. Utterback in Support of Debtors’ Early Day Pleadings* [ECF# 9].

8. On April 4, 2013, the Court entered an *Order Granting Debtors’ Motion to Approve Form and Manner of Limited Notice and Establishing Master Service List* [ECF #35], authorizing the Debtor to maintain a Master Service List consistent with Local Rule 2002-1(H) (the “Master Service List”).

9. On May 22, 2013, this Court entered an Order establishing procedures for compensation of professional fees and reimbursement of costs (the “Comp Procedures Order”) [ECF #224].

10. The Comp Procedures Order authorizes estate professionals to receive 80% of their incurred fees and 100% of costs on a monthly basis.

11. On May 23, 2013, this Court entered a final and stipulated Order authorizing debtor-in-possession financing as well as use of cash collateral (the “DIP Cash Collateral Order”).

12. The DIP Cash Collateral Order provides for a carve out of ECC’s fees in the sum of \$60,000.00 per month for May, June, and July 2013, respectively (the “Fee Carveout”).

13. On May 23 and 24, 2013, the Debtors filed motions seeking orders approving bid and sale procedures for the Late Phase and Early Phase portions of their businesses (collectively, the “Bid Procedures Motions”) [ECF#s 231 and 234, respectively].

14. On May 31, 2013, the Debtors filed an *Emergency Motion for Payment of and Allowance of Administrative Expense Nunc Pro Tunc to May 28, 2013* [ECF #257] seeking to allow the Debtors to pay an administrative expense to Ricoh USA, Inc. (“Ricoh”) for unpaid invoices incurred for the printing, service and notice of the Bid Procedures Motions (the “Admin Expense Motion”). After notice and hearing, on June 14, 2013, the Court granted the Admin Expense Motion allowing the Debtors to pay Ricoh for its service costs (the “First Admin Expense Order”) [ECF #318].¹

15. Also on June 14, 2013, the Court entered orders granting the Bid Procedures Motions [ECF#s 316 and 317, respectively] (the “Bid Procedures Orders”). The Bid Procedures Motion, the Bid Procedures Orders and all other related pleadings to the sale of the Late Phase and Early Phase portions of the Debtors’ business are collectively referred to as the “Sale Pleadings”.

¹ The amounts allowed have not been paid by the Debtors as of the date of this Motion.

16. The Debtors are required to serve notice of the Sale Pleadings pursuant to (i) Sections 363, 364 and 365 of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101–1532 (the “Bankruptcy Code”), (ii) Bankruptcy Rules 2002(a)(2), 6004, 6006 and 9014, and (iii) Rule 6004-1 of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Florida (the “Local Rules”). Accordingly, the Debtor is unable to utilize the Master Service List for service of the Sale Pleadings and must instead serve all creditors in this case.

17. Due to the length of the documents and large number of parties entitled to receive notice in this case, costs associated with noticing and service of the Sale Pleadings are estimated to be in the high several thousands of dollars. As such, the Debtors continue to require the assistance of Ricoh in order to comply with service requirements. In order to fund these mounting expenses, through this Motion, as it did in the first Admin Expense Motion, the Debtors seek to have these Service Costs (defined below) and future Service Costs deemed administrative expenses payable by the Debtors or reimbursable to ECC, as further explained below.

18. Moreover, as Debtors’ counsel, ECC is required to expend a significant amount of actual out of pocket costs that are not required of other estate professionals (e.g., ECC has paid for the actual Chapter 11 filing fees and for the costs of court reporter at auction).

19. Based on the limits of the Fee Carveout vis-à-vis the actual fees incurred in these Chapter 11 cases, ECC has not received reimbursement of any of its actual costs as contemplated by the Comp Procedures Order.

III. RELIEF REQUESTED

20. The Debtors, hereby, seek an Order of the Court authorizing the Debtors to reimburse ECC for its actual incurred expenses *nunc pro tunc* to the Petition Date.

21. ECC has incurred a total of \$26,012.58 in actual expenses from March 29, 2013 through June 26, 2013 (See schedule of expenses incurred attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”**) (the “Expenses”).

22. The Debtors, with the agreement of counsel for the secured lender, Oxford Finance, LLC. (“Oxford”), respectfully request the entry of an order authorizing the Debtors to reimburse ECC for its actual out of pocket expenses incurred up to and including fifteen thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$15,000.00) per month (collectively the “Expense Cap”) *nunc pro tunc* to the Petition Dater. Should the actual expenses incurred exceed the Expense Cap, then ECC will continue to carry the balance of the difference or request further relief from the Court.

23. The Debtors shall add a line item for the Expense Cap to their monthly forecast for the expenses and submit accompanying invoices in their Monthly Operating Report.

24. Additionally, the Debtors seek authority to be excused from the requirement of filing a notice and attending a hearing for the allowance and payment of its fees and costs as the Expense Cap has not been exceeded, subject, of course, to the ECC filing its fee applications in the ordinary course of these Chapter 11 cases.

25. Based on the foregoing, the incurrence by ECC of actual costs have provided and continue to provide a necessary and substantial benefit to the Estate by assuring compliance with the Bankruptcy Rules and notice to all interested parties. As this Court is aware, ECC is not receiving the majority of its actual fees for service provided to the Estate. To require ECC to continue to come out of pocket for actual expenses incurred is not equitable. As such, Oxford has agreed that it will support payment of the expenses incurred up to and including the Expense Cap and that any deviation in the budget approved in the DIP Cash Collateral Order resulting

from the Expense Cap will not, in any event, be considered an event of default of the DIP Cash Collateral Order.

26. Accordingly, the associated administrative expenses should be allowed and this Motion granted subject to the Expense Cap.

WHEREFORE, the Debtors respectfully request that the Court enter an Order: (i) authorizing the Debtors to incur or reimburse ECC for administrative expenses as set forth in this Motion subject to the Expense Cap, and (ii) granting any other relief the Court deems equitable and just.
