ORDER GRANTING AMENDED AND RENEWED MOTION OF THE DEBTORS FOR:
(I) SUBSTANTIVE CONSOLIDATION OF THE DEBTORS' ESTATES; (II)
APPROVAL OF PRO RATA DISTRIBUTIONS ON ACCOUNT OF ADMINISTRATIVE
EXPENSE CLAIMS; (III) AUTHORIZATION TO DISSOLVE DEBTOR ENTITIES;
(IV) APPROVAL OF PROCEDURE TO DISMISS; AND (V) RELATED RELIEF

Upon consideration of the Amended and Renewed Motion of the Debtors for an Order: (I) Substantively Consolidating the Debtors' Estates; (II) Approving Pro Rata Distributions on Account of Administrative Expense Claims; (III) authorizing the Dissolution of the Debtors; (IV) Dismissing the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases; and (V) Granting Related Relief (the "Motion")¹; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and consideration of the Motion and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and venue being proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and sufficient notice of the Motion having been given under the particular circumstances; and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and the Court having considered the Motion, and the arguments of counsel made, and the evidence

adduced, at the hearing on the Motion; and it appearing that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion constitute just cause for the relief granted herein; and it appearing that the relief requested by the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, its estate, its creditors, and other parties in interest; and after due deliberation thereon; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Motion is **GRANTED** as set forth herein.
- 2. All objections to the Motion or the relief requested therein that have not been withdrawn, waived, or settled, and all reservations of rights included therein, are overruled on the merits and denied with prejudice.
 - 3. The Chapter 11 Cases shall be substantively consolidated.
- 4. The Pro Rata Distribution proposed by the Debtors is approved and the Debtors are authorized to make the distributions as set forth in the Motion.
- 5. The authorized representative of the Debtors is hereby authorized to file, as and when such representative determines to do so, with any necessary state entities, a copy of this Order and such other documents as may be necessary to wind up or dissolve the entities.
- 6. After the distribution to administrative claim holders and upon dissolution of the Debtors, the Debtors may transfer any remaining cash to Citizens Bank.
 - 7. The Chapter 11 Cases shall be dismissed effective August 28, 2020.
- 8. Notwithstanding section 349 of the Bankruptcy Code, all prior Orders of this Court entered in these Chapter 11 Cases, and all terms of this Order shall remain in full force and effect and shall survive the dismissal of these Chapter 11 Cases.

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9. Notwithstanding any applicability of any Bankruptcy Rules, the terms and

conditions of the Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry, and the

Debtors and the Committee shall be, and hereby are, authorized to make distributions pursuant to

the Proposed Pro Rata Distribution and to take such other actions as are necessary and appropriate

to effectuate the terms of this Order.

10. The Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to any matters, claims, rights

or disputes arising from or relating to the interpretation or implementation of this Order and any

other order of the Court entered in the Chapter 11 Case.

11. This order is effective immediately.
