The financial information and supplemental information contained herein are unaudited, preliminary, and subject to change. Adjustments may have been made to prior periods as a result of quarterly closing procedures, process improvements and new information.

While the Debtors made reasonable efforts to follow measures from Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in the United States ("US GAAP"), the Debtors do not purport to represent financial information and / or financial statements in accordance with US GAAP as they are unaudited and subject to further review and potential adjustments which may have a material impact. As consistent with the Debtors' historical practice, certain adjustments including, but not limited to, reserves and inventory adjustments may only be updated on a quarterly basis with retroactive adjustments.

Accordingly, this Monthly Operating Report is presented solely for the purpose of complying with monthly reporting requirements of the United States Bankruptcy Court and should not be used, or relied upon, for investment or any other purposes. Certain information included are reported on a consolidated basis for all 3 Debtors in the jointly administered case.

The Debtors have historically consolidated 4274 Colby, LLC with its financial information due to its 50% equity ownership and while the Debtors made reasonable efforts to manually adjust, certain financial information may include activity related to the 4274 Colby, LLC entity.

As the Debtors are currently proceeding with the claim reconciliation process, adjustments to pre-petition claim amounts are not reflected in the Debtors financial statements.

On May 19, 2020, the Court entered an order approving the sale of certain of the Debtors' Assets through an Asset Purchase Agreement with GenCanna Acquisition Corp. ("GAC") which successfully closed on May 29, 2020. Concurrent with the sale, the Debtors entered into a Transition Services Agreement ("TSA") whereby Debtors will work on transitioning the assets and operations purchased by GAC during the defined transition services period. As part of the accounting of the sale transaction, assets purchased by GAC resulted in the derecognition of the assets previously owned by the Debtors.

For the post-sale Monthly Operating Reports during the transition period, certain assets have not been derecognized as title transfer to GAC is pending or GAC purchased the rights to the proceeds. As such, a corresponding estimated liability was recorded on the Debtors books to record the future transfer of asset titles and / or the distribution of proceeds once collected by the Debtors. For example, if GAC purchased the proceeds of a \$4M note, the Debtors would have recorded a corresponding \$4M liability to GAC.

Pursuant to the TSA, the Debtors have been operating on behalf of GAC to conduct sales and normal business operations. As such, the Debtors TSA related sales and cash collections are due to GAC and recorded in the Debtors books and records accordingly. The Debtors also incurred TSA expenses which are reimbursed in full and funded by GAC throughout the TSA period with the exception for legal fees whereby the reconciliation for certain legal fees remain ongoing and once completed, will be reimbursed by GAC.

The Debtors continue to incur executive and other payroll obligations, including in connection with performing obligations under the TSA. All of the Debtors' payroll obligations, with the exception of payroll for the Debtors' Chief Wind-Down Officer and a portion of the costs related to security at the Mayfield property, are reimbursable under the TSA. For the avoidance of doubt, the Debtors represent that to the best of their knowledge, information and belief as of the date of this filing, GAC has not committed to employ the Debtors' Chief Wind-Down Officer, or any person who currently serves as a member of the board of directors or similar governing body of any Debtor. Nor, to the best of the Debtors' knowledge, information and belief, are any of the foregoing individuals in discussions with GAC as of the date of this filing about the possibility of taking on such a role with GAC.
