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**NOTICE REGARDING DISPOSITION OF
PROOFS OF CLAIM FILED IN CHAPTER 11 CASES**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on April 7, 2020, (the “Petition Date”), each of the above-captioned debtors (each, a “Debtor” and, collectively, the “Debtors”) commenced a case (collectively, the “Chapter 11 Cases”) by filing a petition for relief under chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Bankruptcy Court”).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, on the Petition Date, the Debtors filed the *Joint Prepackaged Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization* [Docket No. 21] (as subsequently amended, modified, or supplemented, the “Plan”);² and April 8, 2020, the Debtors filed the *Disclosure Statement for the Debtors’ Joint Prepackaged Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization* [Docket No. 22] (the “Disclosure Statement”).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, on June 30, 2020, the Court entered the *Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order Approving the Disclosure Statement for, and*

Confirming, the Debtors' Joint Prepackaged Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization [Docket No. 556] (the "Confirmation Order"), thereby approving the Disclosure Statement and confirming the Plan. The Plan became effective on July 7, 2020 (the "Effective Date"). *See* Docket No. 568.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, under the Plan, holders of claims against the Debtors were not required to file proofs of claim in the Chapter 11 Cases, unless such claims were for damages arising from the Debtors' rejection of a contract or lease ("Rejection Damages").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, to the extent you filed a proof of claim in the Chapter 11 Cases that did not assert a claim for Rejection Damages, your proof of claim will not be adjudicated in the Bankruptcy Court. Rather, your claim will be determined, resolved, or adjudicated, as the case may be, in a manner as if the Chapter 11 Cases had not been commenced and shall survive the Effective Date as if the Chapter 11 Cases had not been commenced.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, to the extent you filed a proof of claim in the Chapter 11 Cases that asserted a claim for Rejection Damages, and the Debtors dispute your damage claim, your claim will be adjudicated in the Bankruptcy Court. If the Debtors do not dispute your claim for Rejection Damages, your claim will be paid in the ordinary course of the Debtors' business.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that you may obtain a copy of the Plan, the Confirmation Order, and all other case pleadings at the Debtors' case website (<https://dm.epiq11.com/Quorum>) or the Bankruptcy Court's website (www.deb.uscourts.gov) (for a fee). Copies of case pleadings also may be examined between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding federal holidays, at the Office of the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, 824 N. Market St., 3rd Floor, Wilmington, Delaware 19801. Finally, copies of case pleadings also may be obtained from Epiq Corporate Restructuring, LLC ("Epiq"), the
