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

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on April 5, 2022, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the "Court") entered an order (Docket No. 950) (the "Disclosure Statement Order"): (a) authorizing the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") to solicit votes on the Modified Combined Disclosure Statement and Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Liquidation of Strike, LLC and its Affiliated Debtors (Docket No. 946) (as may be amended, supplemented, or modified from time to time and including all exhibits and supplements thereto, the "Plan" or "Disclosure Statement" or "Plan and Disclosure Statement," as applicable); (b) conditionally approving the Disclosure Statement as containing "adequate information" pursuant to section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code; (c) approving the solicitation documents to be included in the solicitation packages; (d) approving procedures for soliciting, receiving, and tabulating votes on the Plan and for filing objections to the Plan; and (e) scheduling certain dates with respect thereto. Jones, in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas, located at 515 Rusk Street, Courtroom 404, Houston, Texas, 77002. Please be advised that the Combined Hearing may be continued from time to time by the Court or the Debtors without further notice other than by such adjournment being announced in open court or by a notice of adjournment filed with the Court and served on other parties entitled to notice.

CRITICAL INFORMATION REGARDING VOTING ON THE PLAN

Voting Record Date. The Voting Record date is April 1, 2022, which is the date for determining which Holders of Claims in Class 3 (General Unsecured Claims) are entitled to vote on the Plan.

Voting Deadline. The deadline for voting on the Plan is May 9, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time) (the "Voting Deadline"). If you received a Solicitation Package, including a Ballot, and intend to vote on the Plan you must: (a) follow the instructions on the Ballot carefully; (b) complete all of the required information on the Ballot; and (c) execute and return your completed Ballot according to and as set forth in detail in the voting instructions on the Ballot so that it is actually received by the Debtors' claims and noticing agent, Epq Corporate Restructuring, LLC (the "Claims and Noticing Agent"), on or before the Voting Deadline. A failure to follow such instructions may disqualify your vote.

Confirmation Objection Deadline. The deadline for filing objections to confirmation of the Plan and the adequacy of the Disclosure Statement is May 9, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time) (the "Confirmation Objection Deadline"). Any objection to the relief sought at the Combined Hearing must: (a) be in writing; (b) comply with the Bankruptcy Rules and Bankruptcy Local Rules; (c) state, with particularity, the legal and factual bases for the objection and, if practicable, a proposed modification to the Plan (or related materials) that would resolve such objection; and (d) be filed with the Court on or before the Confirmation Objection Deadline. **UNLESS AN OBJECTION IS TIMELY SERVED AND FILED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS NOTICE IT MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED BY THE COURT.**

The Plan Supplement. The Debtors will file the Plan Supplement on or before May 2, 2022, and will serve notice on parties in Interest, which will: (a) inform parties that the Debtors filed the Plan Supplement; (b) list the information contained in the Plan Supplement; and (c) explain how parties may obtain copies of the Plan Supplement.

ARTICLE XII OF THE PLAN CONTAINS RELEASE, EXCULPATION, AND INJUNCTION PROVISIONS, AND ARTICLE XIII.C CONTAINS A THIRD-PARTY RELEASE. YOU ARE ADVISED TO REVIEW AND CONSIDER THE PLAN CAREFULLY BECAUSE YOUR RIGHTS MIGHT BE AFFECTED THEREUNDER.

ALL HOLDERS OF CLAIMS OR INTERESTS THAT DO NOT (X) ELECT TO OPT OUT OF THE RELEASES CONTAINED IN ARTICLE XIII.C OF THE PLAN, OR (Y) TIMELY FILE WITH THE BANKRUPTCY COURT ON THE DOCKET OF THE CHAPTER 11 CASES AN OBJECTION TO THE RELEASES CONTAINED IN ARTICLE XIII.C OF THE PLAN THAT IS NOT RESOLVED BEFORE CONFIRMATION WILL BE DEEMED TO HAVE EXPRESSLY, UNCONDITIONALLY, GENERALLY, INDIVIDUALLY, AND COLLECTIVELY CONSENTED TO THE RELEASE AND DISCHARGE OF ALL CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION AGAINST THE DEBTORS AND THE RELEASED PARTIES.

YOU ARE ADVISED TO CAREFULLY REVIEW AND CONSIDER THE PLAN, INCLUDING THE RELEASE, EXCULPATION, AND INJUNCTION PROVISIONS IN ARTICLE XII OF THE PLAN, AS YOUR RIGHTS MIGHT BE AFFECTED.

Public Notification of Activity in a 100-Year Floodplain for Proposed Taxiway Lima Construction at Ellington Airport, Houston, Texas

The Houston Airport System (HAS) intends to construct a parallel taxiway to provide access to Runway 4-22 and Runway end 35L at Ellington Airport (EFD) to address safety and efficiency of the EFD airfield. The proposed project would include construction of a taxiway (Taxiway Lima) with a width of 75 feet, length of 10,295 feet, and 30-foot shoulders. Additionally, there would be five runway connectors each approximately 500 feet in length, and two apron connectors about 150 feet in length.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration Orders 1050.1F and 5050.4B. Per Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management, HAS and FAA have determined that a small portion of the proposed project will encroach on the 100-year floodplain. A floodplain encroachment is defined as any action within a base floodplain that could obstruct flood flows. A portion of the proposed Taxiway Lima project would encroach upon a regulated (100-year) floodplain near Runway end 35L.

The construction of Taxiway Lima would introduce a minor portion of fill material into the existing 100-year floodplain as it is described and located in Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) Number Panel 48201C1060M effective on the 6th of January 2017. A portion of the taxiway would encroach upon approximately 339,768 square feet (sf) or 7.8 acres of a regulated floodplain (Horsepen Bayou floodplain), resulting in reduction of approximately 5.0 acre-feet of flood storage. To mitigate the increases in impervious surfaces and loss of flood storage, a detention basin and diversion weir were proposed and have since been constructed in an earlier phase of Airport development. Based on the results of the Hydrologic and Hydraulic (H&H) Analysis, it was determined that the project’s impact on the floodplain is considered negligible; therefore, would not result in increases to the 10-year or 100-year water surface elevations along Horsepen Bayou; nor would the project result in an adverse impact on the floodplain’s natural and beneficial floodplain values. A detention pond and diversion weir have already been constructed to minimize the project’s effects on the floodplain by matching 10-year and 100-year post-project peak flow rates with existing conditions at the downstream end of Airport property along Horsepen Bayou. The encroachment would not impact existing infrastructure, would not have a high probability of loss of human life, safe airport operations will not be affected, and aircraft services will not be interrupted.

A Draft Categorical Exclusion (CATEX) has been prepared for the Taxiway Lima project. The CATEX and its supporting materials are available online at: <https://houston.tx.gov/has-public-notice.html>. The public comment period will last for fifteen days after this initial notice. The FAA encourages interested parties to review the Draft CATEX and provide written comments during the public comment period by contacting Kim Tourloukis, HAS Environmental by phone at (281) 233-1177 or e-mail at kim.tourloukis@houston.tx.gov. If requested, an opportunity for a Public Meeting to review the project and provide comments may be granted in accordance with FAA policy and floodplain review. Please provide written comments or, if you would like to request a Public Meeting submit a request for a Public Meeting, by April 26, 2022, or 15 days from after date of publication of this Notice, whichever is later. In accordance with Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “*Code*”) and Section 394.9025 of the Texas Housing Finance Corporations Act, Chapter 394, Texas Local Government Code, as amended, notice is hereby given that The Southeast Texas Housing Finance Corporation (the “*Corporation*”) will hold a public hearing telephonically at 11:00 a.m. Central time on Monday, April 18, 2022. All persons interested may monitor and participate in the hearing by calling (800) 504-4496 (a toll-free telephone number) and entering 4844663, followed by a pound key (#) promptly at 11:00 a.m. Central time on Monday, April 18, 2022. The Corporation’s designated hearing officer will conduct the hearing on behalf of the Texas Counties of Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Galveston, Liberty, Matagorda, Walker, Waller and Wharton and the Texas Cities of Baytown, Deer Park, Dickinson, La Marque, La Porte, League City, Pasadena, Santa Fe, Shoreacres, Texas City and Tomball (the “*Sponsoring Political Subdivisions*”).

The purpose of the hearing is to provide residents of the Sponsoring Political Subdivisions an opportunity to comment on the proposed issuance by the Corporation of its Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds to be issued in one or more series (the “*Bonds*”) in an aggregate face amount of not more than \$25,000,000. The Bonds will be issued for the benefit of Gateway Lake Jackson Preservation LLC or an affiliate thereof (the “*Borrower*”), in connection with the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of a multifamily housing development known as Gateway at Lake Jackson located at 111 Loganberry Street, Lake Jackson, Texas 77566 and consisting of approximately 160 units (the “*Development*”). The Borrower will own the Development. It is anticipated that a wholly-owned affiliate of Southeast Texas Multifamily Resources, Inc., an affiliate of the Corporation, will own the land on which the Development will be located and lease such land to the Borrower. Further, it is anticipated that the general partner of the Borrower will be wholly-owned by Southeast Texas Multifamily Resources, Inc.

The Bonds will be limited obligations of the Corporation, payable solely from the revenues, receipts and resources of the Corporation pledged to their payment. The Bonds will not constitute an indebtedness or obligation of any of the Sponsoring Political Subdivisions (or any other city, county or other municipal or political corporation or subdivision of the State of Texas) or of the State of Texas, or a loan of credit of any of them, within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory provision.
