CORPORATE RESOLUTIONS – FAIRPORT BAPTIST HOMES

At a special meeting of the Board of Directors of Fairport Baptist Homes Adult Care Facility, Inc., a New York not-for-profit corporation (“FBH Adult Care”), duly constituted and held virtually on April 29, 2022, the following resolutions were discussed and thereafter adopted by unanimous consent (collectively, the “Resolutions”):

WHEREAS, the FBH Board of Directors has evaluated and considered the financial condition, results of operations and projected cashflows of FBH, purchase offer received by FBH and other available options, along with information and recommendations from legal counsel and other professional advisors; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:

RESOLVED, that in the judgment of the Board of Directors, it is in the best interests of FBH, its residents, employees, creditors and other interested parties, that FBH pursue the sale of all assets to The Friendly Home (“Friendly Home”)¹ through the filing of a voluntary petition under the provisions of Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”);

RESOLVED, that the Chief Executive Officer (the “Authorized Officer”) is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, on behalf of FBH, to take all necessary actions and make all necessary preparations for FBH to commence a case under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the “Chapter 11 Case”), and to commence the Chapter 11 Case, in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of New York, Rochester Division (the “Bankruptcy Court”), on or about May 6, 2022;

RESOLVED, that the Authorized Officer of FBH shall be and hereby is authorized and directed to do and perform all such acts and things to be prepared to execute and file all petitions, plans, pleadings, schedules, lists, statements, applications, documents, certificates and other papers, and to take such other steps as may be deemed necessary or desirable to conduct the Chapter 11 Case and to effectuate the desired sale of FBH;

RESOLVED, that FBH shall employ, subject to any requisite Bankruptcy Court approval, the law firm of LIPPES MATHIAS LLP as bankruptcy counsel to represent and assist FBH in carrying out its duties under the Bankruptcy Code, and to take any and all actions to advance FBH’s rights and obligations, including filing any pleadings; and in connection therewith, the Authorized Officer is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be filed an appropriate application for authority to retain the services of LIPPES MATHIAS LLP;

RESOLVED, that FBH shall employ, subject to any requisite Bankruptcy Court approval, such other professionals and persons as the Authorized Officer determines are necessary in order to conduct the Chapter 11 Case and to operate the business while subject to the jurisdiction of the Bankruptcy Court;

¹ Or a new designee corporate entity formed by Friendly Home, for a total purchase price of \$8,250,000.


RESOLVED, that in addition to the specific authorizations heretofore conferred upon the Authorized Officer, the Authorized Officer and such other officers of FBH as the Authorized Officer shall from time to time designate, and any employees or agents (including counsel) designated by or directed by the Authorized Officer, be authorized and empowered to cause FBH to enter into, execute, deliver, certify, file and/or record, and perform such agreements, instruments, motions, declarations, affidavits, applications for approvals or ruling of governmental or regulatory authorities, certificates and other documents, and to take such other actions as in the judgment of such officer shall be or become necessary, proper and desirable to conduct the Chapter 11 Case and to effectuate the desired sale of FBH; and

RESOLVED, that any and all actions heretofore or hereafter taken by the officers or directors of FBH in the name of and on behalf of FBH in furtherance of any or all of the foregoing resolutions are hereby ratified and confirmed in their entirety.

I, the undersigned, Chief Executive Officer of FBH, do hereby certify that the foregoing is a true, complete and accurate copy of the resolutions duly adopted by the Board of Directors of FBH by unanimous consent; and I do further certify that these resolutions have not been altered, amended, repealed or rescinded and are now in full force and effect.


