**NOTICE OF REORGANIZED DEBTORS’
 SIXTEENTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CERTAIN (A) NO LIABILITY CLAIMS,
 (B) DUPLICATE CLAIMS, (C) INSUFFICIENT DOCUMENTATION CLAIMS,
 (D) SATISFIED CLAIMS, AND (E) AMENDED CLAIMS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on October 12, 2022 Pier 1 Imports, Inc. and its reorganized debtor affiliates (collectively, the “Reorganized Debtors”)² filed the *Reorganized Debtors’ Fifteenth Omnibus Objection to Certain (A) No Liability Claims, (B) Duplicate Claims, (C) Insufficient Documentation Claims, (D) Satisfied Claims, and (E) Amended Claims* (the “Omnibus Objection”) with the Bankruptcy Court. A copy of the Omnibus Objection is attached to this notice (the “Objection Notice”) as **Exhibit A**. By the Omnibus Objection, the Reorganized Debtors are seeking to modify or disallow and expunge certain claims, including your claim(s), as set forth on **Schedules 1-5** attached hereto, because the Reorganized Debtors allege your claim(s): (i) is a claim for which the Debtors’ books and records reflect no liability, (ii) constitutes a duplicate of other filed claims, (iii) does not contain sufficient documentation to support the claim, (iv) is a claim which has previously been satisfied and for which the Debtors reflect no ongoing liability, and/or (v) has been amended or superseded by a subsequently filed claim.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT on March 17, 2020, the Bankruptcy Court entered the *Order (I) Approving Procedures for Filing Omnibus Objections to Claims, (II) Approving the Form and Manner of the Notice of Omnibus Objections, and (III) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 382] (the “Order”), by which the Bankruptcy Court approved procedures for filing omnibus objections to proofs of claim and requests for allowance and payment of administrative expenses (collectively, the “Claims” and each individually, a “Claim”) in connection with the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (the “Omnibus Objection Procedures”).

YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS NOTICE BECAUSE ALL CLAIMS LISTED HEREIN THAT YOU FILED AGAINST ONE OR MORE OF THE DEBTORS IN THE ABOVE-CAPTIONED CHAPTER 11 CASES ARE SUBJECT TO THE OBJECTION. Contents. Each Response must contain the following (at a minimum):

1. a caption setting forth the name of the Bankruptcy Court, the name of the Debtors, and the case number and the title of the Omnibus Objection to which the Response is directed;
2. the claimant's name and an explanation for the amount of the Claim;
3. a concise statement setting forth the reasons why the Bankruptcy Court should not sustain the Omnibus Objection with respect to your Claim(s), including, without limitation, the specific factual and legal bases upon which the claimant will rely in opposing the Omnibus Objection;

4. a copy of any other documentation or other evidence of the Claim, to the extent not already included with the Claim, upon which the claimant will rely in opposing the Omnibus Objection at the hearing; and
5. your name, address, telephone number and email address and/or the name, address, telephone number and email address of your attorney and/or designated representative to whom the attorneys for the Reorganized Debtors should serve a reply to the Response, if any (collectively, the “Notice Addresses”). If a Response contains Notice Addresses that are different from the name and/or address listed on the Claim, the Notice Addresses will control and will become the service address for future service of papers with respect to all of your Claims listed in the Omnibus Objection (including all Claims to be disallowed and expunged and the surviving claims) and only for those Claims in the Omnibus Objection.

Additional Information. To facilitate a resolution of the Omnibus Objection, your Response should also include the name, address, telephone number, and email address of the party with authority to reconcile, settle or otherwise resolve the Omnibus Objection on the claimant’s behalf (the “Additional Addresses”). Unless the Additional Addresses are the same as the Notice Addresses, the Additional Addresses will *not* become the service address for future service of papers.

Failure to File Your Timely Response. If you fail to file your Response on or before the Response Deadline in compliance with the procedures set forth in this Notice and timely serve it on the Reorganized Debtors’ attorneys, the Reorganized Debtors will present to the Bankruptcy Court an appropriate order granting the relief requested in the Omnibus Objection *without further notice* to you.

Hearing Attendance. If you file a Response to the Omnibus Objection, then you should plan to appear at the hearing on the Omnibus Objection. The Reorganized Debtors, however, reserve the right to continue the hearing with respect to the Omnibus Objection and the Response.

Rescheduling the Hearing. If the Bankruptcy Court determines that the hearing on the Omnibus Objection will require substantial time for the presentation of argument and/or evidence, then the Bankruptcy Court, in its discretion, may reschedule the hearing.

Each Objection Is a Contested Matter. Each Claim subject to an Omnibus Objection and the Response thereto shall constitute a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014, and any order entered by the Bankruptcy Court will be deemed a separate order with respect to such Claim.

Additional Information

Reply of the Reorganized Debtors. The Reorganized Debtors may file a reply to your Response or reply in oral argument at the hearing. In such event, the Reorganized Debtors are permitted to file their reply no later than one calendar day before the hearing on the Omnibus Objection and the Response.

Additional Discovery. Upon receipt of your Response, the Reorganized Debtors may determine that discovery is necessary in advance of the hearing on the Omnibus Objection and your Response. In such event, the Reorganized Debtors will serve separate notice to the Notice Addresses that the scheduled hearing will be treated as a status conference during which the parties will request that the Bankruptcy Court issue a scheduling order to facilitate resolution of the Response. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing herein modifies any parties' right to seek discovery or request that the scheduled hearing be treated as a status conference.

Requests for Information. If you have any questions regarding the Omnibus Objection and/or if you wish to obtain a copy of the Omnibus Objection or related documents, you may call the Reorganized Debtors' notice agent at (866) 977-0883. You may also obtain a copy of the Omnibus Objection or related documents by visiting the Reorganized Debtors' website at <https://dm.epiq11.com/case/pier1>.

Reservation of Rights. Nothing in this Notice or the Omnibus Objection constitutes a waiver of the Reorganized Debtors' right to assert any claims, counterclaims, rights of offset or recoupment, preference actions, fraudulent-transfer actions, or any other claims against the claimant of the Reorganized Debtors. Unless the Bankruptcy Court allows your Claims or specifically orders otherwise, the Reorganized Debtors have the right to object on any grounds to the Claims (or to any other Claims or causes of action you may have filed or that have been scheduled by the Reorganized Debtors) at a later date. In such event, you will receive a separate notice of any such objections.

**REORGANIZED DEBTORS’ SIXTEENTH OMNIBUS
OBJECTION TO CERTAIN (A) NO LIABILITY CLAIMS,
(B) DUPLICATE CLAIMS, (C) INSUFFICIENT DOCUMENTATION CLAIMS,
(D) SATISFIED CLAIMS, AND (E) AMENDED CLAIMS**

Pier 1 Imports, Inc. and its reorganized debtor affiliates (collectively, the “Reorganized Debtors”), file this omnibus objection (this “Objection”) and seek entry of an order, substantially in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** (the “Order”):

- disallowing and expunging the claims identified on **Schedule 1** to the Order (collectively, the “No Liability Claims”) in their entirety because based on the Debtors’ books and records, the Debtors have no liability for such claims;
- disallowing and expunging the claims identified on **Schedule 2** to the Order (collectively, the “Duplicate Claims”) in their entirety because such claims constitute duplicates of other filed claims;

- disallowing and expunging the claims identified on **Schedule 3** to the Order (collectively, the “Insufficient Documentation Claims”) in their entirety because such claims fail to specify sufficiently the basis for such claims or provide sufficient supporting documentation therefor;
- disallowing and expunging the claims identified on **Schedule 4** to the Order (the “Satisfied Claims”) in their entirety because, based on the Debtors’ books and records, such claim has been paid or satisfied and no liability exists in connection therewith; and
- disallowing and expunging the claims identified on **Schedule 5** to the Order (collectively, the “Amended Claims” and together with the No Liability Claims, the Duplicate Claims, the Insufficient Documentation Claims, and the Satisfied Claims, the “Disputed Claims”) in their entirety because such claims have been amended or superseded by subsequently filed claims

In support of this Objection, the Reorganized Debtors respectfully state as follows:

Jurisdiction

1. The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia (the “Court”) has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Standing Order of Reference from the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia*, dated July 10, 1984. The Reorganized Debtors confirm their consent, pursuant to Rule 7008 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”), to the entry of a final order by the Court in connection with this Motion to the extent that it is later determined that the Court, absent consent of the parties, cannot enter final orders or judgments in connection herewith consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution.

2. The bases for the relief requested herein are sections 502 and 1106(a)(1) of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101–1532 (the “Bankruptcy Code”), Bankruptcy Rules 3007 and 9014, and Rule 3007–1 of the Local Bankruptcy Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia (the “Local Rules”).

Relief Requested

3. By this Objection, the Reorganized Debtors respectfully request entry of an order (a) modifying or disallowing and expunging the Disputed Claims identified on **Schedules 1-5** to the Order and (b) granting related relief.

Background

4. On February 17, 2020 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtors each filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. A detailed description surrounding the facts and circumstances of these chapter 11 cases is set forth in the *Declaration of Robert J. Riesbeck, Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer of Pier 1 Imports, Inc., in Support of Chapter 11 Petitions and First Day Motions* [Docket No. 30]. On March 16, 2020, the Debtors filed their schedules of assets and liabilities and statements of financial affairs [Docket No. 363]. On July 30, 2020, the Court entered the *Order Confirming the Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Pier 1 Imports, Inc. and Its Debtor Affiliates* [Docket No. 967] (the "Plan") and the Effective Date (as defined in the Plan) occurred on October 9, 2020 [Docket No. 1088].

The Claims Reconciliation Process

5. On March 13, 2020 the Court entered the *Order (I) Setting Bar Dates for Filing Proofs of Claim, Including Requests for Payment Under Section 503(b)(9), (II) Establishing Amended Schedules Bar Date and Rejection Damages Bar Date, (III) Approving the Form of and Manner for Filing Proofs of Claim, Including Section 503(b)(9) Requests, (IV) Approving Notice of Bar Dates, and (V) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 345] (the "General Bar Date Order"), which, among other things, established the following deadline for filing proofs of claim (collectively, the "General Bar Dates"): (a) April 17, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. prevailing Eastern time, as the deadline for all persons and entities holding or wishing to assert a "claim" (as defined in section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code) against any of the Debtors that arose before the Petition

Date (each, a “Claim”), including any claim arising under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code, to file proof of such Claim in writing; (b) April 17, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. prevailing Eastern Time, as the deadline for all governmental units holding or wishing to assert a Claim against any of the Debtors that arose before the Petition Date to file proof of such Claim in writing; and (c) the later of (i) the General Claims Bar Date or the Governmental Bar Date (each as defined in the General Bar Date Order), as applicable, or (ii) 4:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern Time, on the date that is 30 days following entry of an order approving the rejection of any executory contract or unexpired lease of the Debtors, as the deadline for all entities holding claims against the Debtors arising from the rejection of executory contracts and unexpired leases of the Debtors, to file proof of such Claim in writing.

6. On June 1, 2020, the Court entered the *Amended Order (I) Setting a Bar Date for Filing Proofs of Administrative Claims Against Certain Debtors, (II) Establishing Administrative Claims Procedures, (III) Approving the Form and Manner of Filing Proofs of Administrative Claims, (IV) Approving Notice of the Administrative Claims Bar Date, and (V) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 737] (the “Admin Claims Bar Date Order” and together with the General Bar Date Order, the “Bar Date Orders”), which, among other things, established June 30, 2020 at 4:00 p.m., as the deadline to file proof of such claim in writing for all persons and entities holding or wishing to assert a claim entitled to administrative priority under 11 U.S.C. § 503 (other than § 503(b)(9)) (each, an “Administrative Claim”) against any of the Debtors that arose between the Petition Date and on or prior to May 31, 2020 (the “Admin Bar Date” and together with the General Bar Dates, the “Bar Dates”) as the deadline to file proof of such Administrative Claim in writing.

7. Written notice of the Bar Dates was mailed to, among others, all known creditors and other known holders of claims against the Debtors, identified as of the date of entry of the Bar

Date Orders, including all entities listed in the Schedules as holding claims against the Debtors, and to all parties who had filed requests for notices under Bankruptcy Rule 2002 as of the date of the Bar Date Orders. In addition to mailing such actual notice, the Debtors also published notice of the Bar Dates in *USA Today* (national edition) and *The Globe and Mail* (national edition in Canada)(with respect to the Bar Dates) and *The New York Times* (national edition)(with respect to the General Bar Dates).

8. On March 17, 2020, the Court entered the *Order (I) Approving Procedures for Filing Omnibus Objections to Claims, (II) Approving the Form and Manner of the Notice of Omnibus Objections, and (III) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 382] approving the Debtors' proposed objection procedures (the "Objection Procedures"). This Objection is filed in accordance with the Objection Procedures.

9. To date, entities have filed approximately 3,500 proofs of claim and requests for allowance and payment of administrative expenses claims against the Debtors on an aggregate basis (collectively, the "Proofs of Claim"), collectively asserting hundreds of millions of dollars in liability. The Reorganized Debtors and their advisors are in the process of reviewing the Proofs of Claim, including supporting documentation, if any, filed with the Proofs of Claim, and reconciling the Proofs of Claim with the Debtors' books and records to determine the validity of the Proofs of Claim. For the reasons set forth in more detail below, and based on their review to date, the Reorganized Debtors have determined that the Disputed Claims are objectionable on the grounds set forth below.

Objection

I. No Liability Claims

10. The Reorganized Debtors object to the No Liability Claims set forth on **Schedule 1** to the Order. Based on their review of the proofs of claim, the Reorganized Debtors have

determined that the No Liability Claims, as filed, do not accurately reflect amounts owed by the Debtors according to their books and records. Instead, the Reorganized Debtors assert that there is no liability for such Claims. As a result, the Reorganized Debtors are seeking an order expunging and disallowing the No Liability Claims, as identified on **Schedule 1** to the Order. Failure to disallow and expunge the No Liability Claims could result in the applicable claimants receiving undue recoveries against the Debtors' estates, to the detriment of other similarly situated creditors. Moreover, elimination of the No Liability Claims will enable the Reorganized Debtors to maintain a more accurate claims register. Accordingly, the Reorganized Debtors request that the Court enter the Order, disallowing and expunging the No Liability Claims identified on **Schedule 1** to the Order.

II. Duplicate Claims

11. The Reorganized Debtors object to the Duplicate Claims. Based on their review of the Proofs of Claim and a thorough analysis of the Debtors' books and records, the Reorganized Debtors have determined that the Duplicate Claims identified on the "Claim to be Disallowed" column on **Schedule 2** to the Order, duplicate amounts requested in the Proof of Claims identified in the "Remaining Claim Number(s)" column on **Schedule 2** to the Order. Failure to disallow and expunge the Duplicate Claims could result in the applicable claimant receiving multiple recoveries against the Debtors' estates, to the detriment of other similarly situated creditors. Moreover, elimination of the Duplicate Claims will enable the Reorganized Debtors to maintain a more accurate claims register. Accordingly, the Reorganized Debtors request that the Court enter the Order, disallowing and expunging the Duplicate Claims identified on **Schedule 2** to the Order. This Objection does not affect the Proofs of Claims labeled as a "Remaining Claim Number(s)"

identified on **Schedule 2** to the Order. The Reorganized Debtors do, however, maintain the right to object to any Proofs of Claim identified as a “Remaining Claim” on any applicable grounds.

III. Insufficient Documentation Claims

12. The Reorganized Debtors object to the Insufficient Documentation Claims identified on **Schedule 3** to the Order. Based on their review of the Proofs of Claim filed in these chapter 11 cases the Insufficient Documentation Claims do not include sufficient information to enable the Reorganized Debtors to reconcile these Proofs of Claim with their books and records.

13. A proof of claim must “set forth the facts necessary to support the claim.” *In re Chain*, 255 B.R. 278, 280 (Bankr. D. Conn. 2000) (citing 9, Resnick & Sommer eds., Collier on Bankruptcy ¶ 3001.09[1] at 3001-27 (15th ed. rev. 2005)) (emphasis added). If the proof of claim fails to set forth the necessary supporting facts, it is “not entitled to the presumption of *prima facie* validity, and the burdens of going forward and of proving its claims by a preponderance of the evidence are on the [claimant].” *In the Matter of Marino*, 90 B.R. 25, 28 (Bankr. D. Conn. 1988); *see also In re Svendson*, 34 B.R. 341, 342 (Bankr. D.R.I. 1983) (stating proofs of claim failed to “set forth all the necessary facts to establish the claim[s].”).

14. Without providing sufficient information or documentation to allow the Reorganized Debtors to reconcile the Insufficient Documentation Claims with their books and records, the Insufficient Documentation Claims fail to satisfy the requirements for a proof of claim. *See Chain*, 255 B.R. at 280. *See also In re 20/20 Sport, Inc.*, 200 B.R. 972, 978 (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. 1996) (“In bankruptcy cases, courts have traditionally analogized a creditor’s claim to a civil complaint, [and] a trustee’s objection to an answer . . .”).

15. Moreover, the Reorganized Debtors should not be required to pay a purported creditor to the detriment of a proven creditor. The elimination of Insufficient Documentation

Claims will streamline the claims-reconciliation process and enable the Reorganized Debtors to maintain a more accurate claims register. Accordingly, the Reorganized Debtors hereby request that the Court enter an order expunging and disallowing the Insufficient Documentation Claims identified on **Schedule 3** of the Order.

IV. Satisfied Claims

16. The Reorganized Debtors object to the Satisfied Claims set forth on **Schedule 4** to the Order. Based on their review of the Proofs of Claim and a thorough analysis of the Debtors' books and records, the Reorganized Debtors have determined that such Satisfied Claims have been paid or otherwise settled and the Debtors no longer have any outstanding liabilities associated therewith. As a result, the Reorganized Debtors are seeking an order expunging and disallowing such Satisfied Claims, as identified on **Schedule 4** to the Order. Failure to disallow and expunge such Satisfied Claims could result in the applicable claimants receiving multiple recoveries against the Debtors' estates, to the detriment of other similarly situated creditors. Moreover, elimination of such Satisfied Claims will enable the Reorganized Debtors to maintain a more accurate claims register. Accordingly, the Reorganized Debtors request that the Court enter the Order, disallowing and expunging such Satisfied Claims identified on **Schedule 4** to the Order.

V. Amended Claims

17. The Reorganized Debtors object to the Amended Claims. Based on their review of the Proofs of Claim, the Reorganized Debtors have determined that the Amended Claims consist of Proofs of Claim that have been amended and/or superseded by subsequently filed proofs of claim, the latter of which are identified in the "Remaining Claim Number(s)" column on **Schedule 5** to the Order. As a result, the earlier filed Proofs of Claim listed in the "Claim to be Disallowed" column no longer represent valid Proofs of Claim against the Debtors' estates.

Failure to disallow and expunge the Amended Claims listed in the “Claim to be Disallowed” column could result in the applicable claimants receiving multiple recoveries against the Debtors’ estates, to the detriment of other similarly situated creditors. Moreover, elimination of the Amended Claims will enable the Reorganized Debtors to maintain a more accurate claims register. Accordingly, the Reorganized Debtors request that the Court enter the Order, disallowing and expunging the Amended Claims listed in the “Claim to be Disallowed” column on **Schedule 5** to the Order. This Objection does not affect the Proofs of Claim identified in the “Remaining Claim Number(s)” column on **Schedule 5** to the Order. The Reorganized Debtors do, however, maintain the right to object to any Proofs of Claim identified as a “Remaining Claim” on any applicable grounds.

Basis for Relief

18. Section 502(a) of the Bankruptcy Code provides that “[a] claim or interest, proof of which is filed under section 501 of this title, is deemed allowed, unless a party in interest . . . objects.” A debtor in possession has the duty to object to the allowance of any claim that is improper. *See* 11 U.S.C. § 1106(a)(1).

19. As set forth in Bankruptcy Rule 3001(f), a properly executed and filed proof of claim constitutes *prima facie* evidence of the validity and the amount of the claim under section 502(a) of the Bankruptcy Code. *See In re Allegheny Int’l, Inc.*, 954 F.2d 167, 173 (3d Cir. 1992). Bankruptcy courts have generally held that in order to receive the benefit of *prima facie* validity, however, the claimant must set forth facts necessary to support the claim. *See In re McCarthy*, No. 04-10493, 2004 WL 5683383, at *5 (Bankr. E.D. Va. July 14, 2004). Additionally, a claimant’s proof of claim is entitled to the presumption of *prima facie* validity under Bankruptcy Rule 3001(f) only until an objecting party shows that there exists a “true dispute” as to the validity

and amount of the claim. *See In re Computer Learning Ctrs., Inc.*, 298 B.R. 569, 578 (Bankr. E.D. Va. 2003) (quoting Collier on Bankruptcy ¶ 3001.09[2] (15th ed. revised 2003)). Once the objecting party refutes an allegation critical to the claim, the burden reverts to the claimant to prove the validity of the claim by a preponderance of the evidence. *Allegheny*, 954 F.2d at 173. In other words, once the *prima facie* validity of a claim is rebutted, “it is for the claimant to prove his claim, not for the objector to disprove it.” *In re Kahn*, 114 B.R. 40, 44 (Bankr. S.D.N.Y. 1990) (citations omitted).

20. For the reasons set forth in this Objection, the Court should disallow and expunge or modify the Disputed Claims as requested in herein. If the Disputed Claims are not formally disallowed and expunged or modified, the potential exists for the applicable claimants to receive recoveries to which they are not entitled, to the detriment of the Debtors’ other stakeholders and, the process of claims administration and reconciliation will be unnecessarily burdensome. Thus, the relief requested in this Objection is necessary to prevent any inappropriate distribution of estate funds and to facilitate the administration of the claims-allowance process.

Separate Contested Matter

21. Each of the above objections to the proofs of claim constitutes a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014. The Reorganized Debtors request that any order entered by the Court with respect to an objection asserted herein will be deemed a separate order with respect to each Claim.

Responses to Omnibus Objections

22. To contest this Objection, a claimant must file and serve a written response to this Objection in accordance with the Objection Procedures. If a claimant fails to file and serve a response in accordance with the Objection Procedures, the Reorganized Debtors may present to

the Court an appropriate order disallowing the Disputed Claim, without further notice to the claimant or a hearing.

Reservation of Rights

23. Nothing contained herein is intended or shall be construed as: (a) an admission as to the amount of, basis for, or validity of any claim against the Debtors under the Bankruptcy Code or other applicable nonbankruptcy law; (b) a waiver of the Reorganized Debtors' or any other party in interest's right to dispute any claim; (c) a promise or requirement to pay any particular claim; (d) an implication or admission that any particular claim is of a type specified or defined in this motion; (e) an admission as to the validity, priority, enforceability, or perfection of any lien on, security interest in, or other encumbrance on property of the Debtors' estates; or (f) a waiver of any claims or causes of action which may exist against any entity under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable law.

Notice

24. The Reorganized Debtors will provide notice of this Objection via first-class mail or email (where available) to the Core Group as defined in the *Order (I) Establishing Certain Notice, Case Management, and Administrative Procedures and (II) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 141] and to holders of the Disputed Claims identified on **Schedules 1-5** to the Order. The Reorganized Debtors submit that, in light of the nature of the relief requested, no other or further notice need be given.

No Prior Request

25. No prior request for the relief sought in this Objection has been made to this or any other court.

WHEREFORE, the Reorganized Debtors respectfully request that the Court enter the Order granting the relief requested herein and such other relief as the Court deems appropriate under the circumstances.

7. Each Amended Claim in the “Claim to be Disallowed” column identified on **Schedule 5** attached to this Order is disallowed and expunged in its entirety; *provided* that nothing in this Order will affect any Proof of Claim listed in the “Remaining Claim Number(s)” column on **Schedule 5**; *provided, further*, that the Reorganized Debtors maintain the right to object to any

claim listed in the “Remaining Claim Number(s)” column on **Schedule 5** on any applicable grounds.

8. Epiq Corporate Restructuring, LLC, the Reorganized Debtors’ notice and claims agent, is directed to update the claims register to reflect the relief granted in this Order.

9. Except as provided in this Order, nothing in this Order will be deemed (a) an admission or finding as to the validity of any Proof of Claim against a Debtor entity, (b) a waiver of the right of the Reorganized Debtors to dispute any Proof of Claim against any Debtor on any grounds whatsoever, at a later date, (c) a promise by or requirement on any Reorganized Debtor to pay any Proof of Claim, (d) an implication or admission that any particular Proof of Claim is of a type specified or defined in this Order, or (e) a waiver of the rights of the Reorganized Debtors under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable law.

10. Each of the Disputed Claims and the objections by the Reorganized Debtors to each of the Disputed Claims, as addressed in the Objection and set forth on **Schedules 1-5**, each attached to this Order, constitute a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014. This Order will be deemed a separate Order with respect to each Disputed Claim. Any stay of this Order pending appeal by any claimants whose Proofs of Claim are subject to this Order will only apply to the contested matter that involves such claimant and will not act to stay the applicability or finality of this Order with respect to the other contested matters identified in the Objection or this Order.

11. The Reorganized Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Order in accordance with the Objection.

12. This Court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
