AMENDED DECLARATION OF
STEVEN N. SERAJEDDINI IN SUPPORT OF THE DEBTORS'
APPLICATION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER AUTHORIZING
THE RETENTION AND EMPLOYMENT OF KIRKLAND & ELLIS LLP
AND KIRKLAND & ELLIS INTERNATIONAL LLP AS ATTORNEYS FOR THE
DEBTORS AND DEBTORS IN POSSESSION EFFECTIVE AS OF OCTOBER 2, 2022

- I, Steven N. Serajeddini, being duly sworn, state the following under penalty of perjury:
- 1. I am the President of Steven N. Serajeddini, P.C., a partner of the law firm of Kirkland & Ellis LLP, located at 601 Lexington Avenue, New York, New York 10022, and a partner of Kirkland & Ellis International, LLP (together with Kirkland & Ellis LLP, collectively, "Kirkland"). I am one of the lead attorneys from Kirkland working on the above-captioned chapter 11 cases. I am a member in good standing of the Bar of the States of Illinois and New York, and I have been admitted to practice in U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. There are no disciplinary proceedings pending against me.

A complete list of each of the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases and the last four digits of their federal tax identification numbers may be obtained on the website of the Debtors' claims and noticing agent at http://dm.epiq11.com/PipelineHealth. The Debtors' service address is 898 N. Pacific Coast Highway, Suite 700, El Segundo, California 90245.

2. I submit this amended² declaration (the "<u>Declaration</u>") in support of the Debtors' Application for Entry of an Order Authorizing the Retention and Employment of Kirkland & Ellis LLP and Kirkland & Ellis International LLP as Attorneys for the Debtors and Debtors in Possession Effective as of October 2, 2022 (the "<u>Application</u>").³ Except as otherwise noted, I have personal knowledge of the matters set forth herein.

Kirkland's Qualifications

- 4. The Debtors seek to retain Kirkland because of Kirkland's recognized expertise and extensive experience and knowledge in the field of debtors' protections, creditors' rights, and business reorganizations under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
- 5. Kirkland has been actively involved in major chapter 11 cases and has represented debtors in many cases, including, among others: *In re Cineworld Group, Plc*, No. 22-90168 (MI) (Bankr. S.D. Tex. Sept. 7, 2022); *In re Altera Infrastructure L.P.*, No. 22-90130 (MI) (Bankr. S.D. Tex. Aug. 14, 2022); and *In re HONX*, No. 22-90035 (MI) (Bankr. S.D. Tex. June 24, 2022).
- 6. In preparing for its representation of the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases, Kirkland has become familiar with the Debtors' business and many of the potential legal issues that may arise in the context of these chapter 11 cases. I believe that Kirkland is both well-qualified and uniquely able to represent the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases in an efficient and timely manner.

This amended Declaration discloses the names of and connections with potential M&A counterparties, which were previously listed as "confidential."

Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the Application.

Services to Be Provided

- 7. Subject to further order of the Court and that certain engagement letter dated August 12, 2022 (the "<u>Engagement Letter</u>"), a copy of which is attached as <u>Exhibit 1</u> to the Order, the Debtors retained Kirkland to render, without limitation, the following legal services:
 - a. advising the Debtors with respect to their powers and duties as debtor in possession in the continued management and operation of their businesses and properties;
 - b. advising and consulting on the conduct of these chapter 11 cases, including all of the legal and administrative requirements of operating in chapter 11;
 - c. attending meetings and negotiating with representatives of creditors and other parties in interest;
 - d. taking all necessary actions to protect and preserve the Debtors' estates, including prosecuting actions on the Debtors' behalf, defending any action commenced against the Debtors, and representing the Debtors in negotiations concerning litigation in which the Debtors are involved, including objections to claims filed against the Debtors' estates;
 - e. preparing pleadings in connection with these chapter 11 cases, including motions, applications, answers, orders, reports, and papers necessary or otherwise beneficial to the administration of the Debtors' estates;
 - f. representing the Debtors in connection with obtaining authority to continue using cash collateral and postpetition financing;
 - g. advising the Debtors in connection with any potential sale of assets;
 - h. appearing before the Court and any appellate courts to represent the interests of the Debtors' estates;
 - i. advising the Debtors regarding tax matters;
 - j. taking any necessary action on behalf of the Debtors to negotiate, prepare, and obtain approval of a disclosure statement and confirmation of a chapter 11 plan and all documents related thereto; and
 - k. performing all other necessary legal services for the Debtors in connection with the prosecution of these chapter 11 cases, including: (i) analyzing the Debtors' leases and contracts and the assumption and assignment or rejection thereof; (ii) analyzing the validity of liens against the Debtors' assets; and (iii) advising the Debtors on corporate and litigation matters.

Professional Compensation

- 8. Kirkland intends to apply for compensation for professional services rendered on an hourly basis and reimbursement of expenses incurred in connection with these chapter 11 cases, subject to the Court's approval and in compliance with applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Bankruptcy Local Rules, and any other applicable procedures and orders of the Court. The hourly rates and corresponding rate structure Kirkland will use in these chapter 11 cases are the same as the hourly rates and corresponding rate structure that Kirkland uses in other debtor representations, and are comparable to the hourly rates and corresponding rate structure that Kirkland uses for complex corporate, securities, and litigation matters whether in court or otherwise, regardless of whether a fee application is required. These rates and the rate structure reflect that such restructuring and other complex matters typically are national in scope and involve great complexity, high stakes, and severe time pressures.
- 9. Kirkland operates in a national marketplace for legal services in which rates are driven by multiple factors relating to the individual lawyer, his or her area of specialization, the firm's expertise, performance, and reputation, the nature of the work involved, and other factors.

10. Kirkland's current hourly rates for matters related to these chapter 11 cases range as follows:⁴

- 11. Kirkland's hourly rates are set at a level designed to compensate Kirkland fairly for the work of its attorneys and paralegals and to cover fixed and routine expenses. Hourly rates vary with the experience and seniority of the individuals assigned. These hourly rates are subject to periodic adjustments to reflect economic and other conditions.⁶
- 12. It is Kirkland's policy to charge its clients in all areas of practice for identifiable, non-overhead expenses incurred in connection with the client's case that would not have been incurred except for representation of that particular client. It is also Kirkland's policy to charge its clients only the amount actually incurred by Kirkland in connection with such items. Examples

⁴ For professionals and paraprofessionals residing outside of the U.S., hourly rates are billed in the applicable currency. When billing a U.S. entity, such foreign rates are converted into U.S. dollars at the then applicable conversion rate. After converting these foreign rates into U.S. dollars, it is possible that certain rates may exceed the billing rates listed in the chart herein. While the rate ranges provided for in this Application may change if an individual leaves or joins Kirkland, and if any such individual's billing rate falls outside the ranges disclosed above, Kirkland does not intend to update the ranges for such circumstances.

Although Kirkland does not anticipate using contract attorneys during these chapter 11 cases, in the unlikely event that it becomes necessary to use contract attorneys, Kirkland will not charge a markup to the Debtors with respect to fees billed by such attorneys. Any contract attorneys or non-attorneys who are employed by the Debtors in connection with work performed by Kirkland will be subject to conflict checks and disclosures in accordance with the requirements of the Bankruptcy Code.

For example, like many of its peer law firms, Kirkland typically increases the hourly billing rate of attorneys and paraprofessionals twice a year in the form of: (a) step increases historically awarded in the ordinary course on the basis of advancing seniority and promotion and (b) periodic increases within each attorney's and paraprofessional's current level of seniority. The step increases do not constitute "rate increases" (as the term is used in the *Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases*, effective November 1, 2013). As set forth in the Order, Kirkland will provide ten business days' notice to the Debtors, the U.S. Trustee, and any official committee before implementing any periodic increases, and shall file such notice with the Court.

of such expenses include postage, overnight mail, courier delivery, transportation, overtime expenses, computer-assisted legal research, photocopying, airfare, meals, and lodging.

- 13. To ensure compliance with all applicable deadlines in these chapter 11 cases, Kirkland utilizes the services of overtime secretaries. Kirkland charges fees for these services pursuant to the Engagement Letter between Kirkland and the Debtors, which permits Kirkland to bill the Debtors for overtime secretarial charges that arise out of business necessity. In addition, Kirkland professionals also may charge their overtime meals and overtime transportation to the Debtors consistent with prepetition practices.
- 14. Kirkland currently charges the Debtors \$0.16 per page for standard duplication in its offices in the United States. Kirkland does not charge its clients for incoming facsimile transmissions. Kirkland has negotiated a discounted rate for Westlaw computer-assisted legal research. Computer-assisted legal research is used whenever the researcher determines that using Westlaw is more cost effective than using traditional (non-computer assisted legal research) techniques.

Compensation Received by Kirkland from the Debtors

\$200,000 to Kirkland, which, as stated in the Engagement Letter, constituted an "advance payment retainer" as defined in Rule 1.15(c) of the Illinois Rules of Professional Conduct and *Dowling v. Chicago Options Assoc., Inc.*, 875 N.E.2d 1012, 1018 (III. 2007). Subsequently, the Debtors paid to Kirkland additional advance payment retainer totaling \$2,900,000 in the aggregate. As stated in the Engagement Letter, any advance payment retainer is earned by Kirkland upon receipt, any advance payment retainer becomes the property of Kirkland upon receipt, the Debtors no longer have a property interest in any advance payment retainer upon Kirkland's receipt, any advance

payment retainer will be placed in Kirkland's general account and will not be held in a client trust account, and the Debtors will not earn any interest on any advance payment retainer.⁷

- 16. As of the Petition Date, the Debtors did not owe Kirkland any amounts for legal services rendered before the Petition Date. Although certain expenses and fees may have been incurred, but not yet applied to Kirkland's advance payment retainer, Kirkland's total advance payment retainer always exceeded any amounts listed or to be listed on statements describing services rendered and expenses incurred (on a "rates times hours" and "dates of expenses incurred" basis) prior to the Petition Date.
- 17. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2016(b), Kirkland has not shared nor agreed to share (a) any compensation it has received or may receive with another party or person, other than with the partners, associates, and contract attorneys associated with Kirkland or (b) any compensation another person or party has received or may receive.

Statement Regarding U.S. Trustee Guidelines

18. Kirkland shall apply for compensation for professional services rendered and reimbursement of expenses incurred in connection with the Debtors' chapter 11 cases in compliance with sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code and applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Rules, Bankruptcy Local Rules, and any other applicable procedures and orders of the Court. Kirkland also intends to make a reasonable effort to comply with the U.S. Trustee's requests for information and additional disclosures as set forth in the *Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by*

The Engagement Letter permits Kirkland to retain any prepetition advance payment retainer held by Kirkland as of the Petition Date rather than applying such prepetition advance payment retainer to pay postpetition fees and expenses. In light of the facts and circumstances of these chapter 11 cases, Kirkland will retain any prepetition advance payment retainer held by Kirkland as of the Petition Date and will not apply any such amounts to postpetition fees and expenses.

Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases Effective As of November 1, 2013 (the "Revised UST Guidelines"), both in connection with this Application and the interim and final fee applications to be filed by Kirkland in these chapter 11 cases.

Attorney Statement Pursuant to Revised UST Guidelines

- 19. The following is provided in response to the request for additional information set forth in Paragraph D.1. of the Revised UST Guidelines:
 - a. **Question**: Did Kirkland agree to any variations from, or alternatives to, Kirkland's standard billing arrangements for this engagement?
 - **Answer**: No. Kirkland and the Debtors have not agreed to any variations from, or alternatives to, Kirkland's standard billing arrangements for this engagement. The rate structure provided by Kirkland is appropriate and is not significantly different from (a) the rates that Kirkland charges for other non-bankruptcy representations or (b) the rates of other comparably skilled professionals.
 - b. **Question**: Do any of the Kirkland professionals in this engagement vary their rate based on the geographic location of the Debtors' chapter 11 cases?
 - **Answer**: No. The hourly rates used by Kirkland in representing the Debtors are consistent with the rates that Kirkland charges other comparable chapter 11 clients, regardless of the location of the chapter 11 case.
 - c. **Question**: If Kirkland has represented the Debtors in the 12 months prepetition, disclose Kirkland's billing rates and material financial terms for the prepetition engagement, including any adjustments during the 12 months prepetition. If Kirkland's billing rates and material financial terms have changed postpetition, explain the difference and the reasons for the difference.

Answer: Kirkland's current hourly rates for services rendered on behalf of the Debtors in the six months prepetition range as follows: ⁸

d. **Question**: Have the Debtors approved Kirkland's budget and staffing plan, and, if so, for what budget period?

Answer: Yes, pursuant to the DIP Order, professionals proposed to be retained by the Debtors are required to provide weekly estimates of fees and expenses incurred in these chapter 11 cases.

Kirkland's Disinterestedness

20. In connection with its proposed retention by the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases, Kirkland undertook to determine whether it had any conflicts or other relationships that might cause it not to be disinterested or to hold or represent an interest adverse to the Debtors. Specifically, Kirkland obtained from the Debtors and their representatives the names of individuals and entities that may be parties in interest in these chapter 11 cases (the "Potential Parties in Interest") and such parties are listed on Schedule 1 hereto. Kirkland has searched its electronic database for its connections to the entities listed on Schedule 1 hereto. In addition, after Kirkland identified all client connections with the parties in interest over a specified time period, Kirkland circulated a survey email to all Kirkland attorneys who billed 10 or more hours to such clients during the prior six years. Further, beyond the individual emails, Kirkland sent a daily report of

new matters firm wide. All Kirkland attorneys are responsible for reviewing the daily report of new matters and raising any potential concerns with respect to new representations. Kirkland did not receive any answers in the affirmative to these emails. Additionally, to the extent that I have been able to ascertain that Kirkland has been retained within the last three years to represent any of the Potential Parties in Interest (or their affiliates, as the case may be) in matters unrelated to these cases, such facts are disclosed on **Schedule 2** attached hereto.

21. Kirkland and certain of its partners and associates may have in the past represented, may currently represent, and likely in the future will represent, entities that may be parties in interest in these chapter 11 cases in connection with matters unrelated (except as otherwise disclosed herein) to the Debtors and these chapter 11 cases. Kirkland has searched its electronic database for its connections to the entities listed on **Schedule 1** attached hereto. The information listed on **Schedule 1** may have changed without our knowledge and may change during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. Accordingly, Kirkland will update this Declaration as necessary and when Kirkland becomes aware of additional material information. The following is a list of the categories that Kirkland has searched:

- 22. To the best of my knowledge, (a) Kirkland is a "disinterested person" within the meaning of section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code, as required by section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, and does not hold or represent an interest adverse to the Debtors' estates and (b) Kirkland has no connection to the Debtors, their creditors, or other parties in interest, except as may be disclosed in this Declaration.
- 23. Listed on <u>Schedule 2</u> to this Declaration are the results of Kirkland's conflicts searches of the above-listed entities.¹⁰ For the avoidance of doubt, Kirkland will not commence a cause of action in these chapter 11 cases against the entities listed on <u>Schedule 2</u> that are current clients of Kirkland (including entities listed below under the "Specific Disclosures" section of this Declaration) unless Kirkland has an applicable waiver on file or first receives a waiver from such entity allowing Kirkland to commence such an action. To the extent that a waiver does not exist or is not obtained from such entity and it is necessary for the Debtors to commence an action against that entity, the Debtors will be represented in such particular matter by conflicts counsel.
- 24. Of the entities listed on <u>Schedule 2</u>, only one represented more than one percent of Kirkland's fee receipts for the twelve-month period ending on September 30, 2022:

As referenced in <u>Schedule 2</u>, the term "current client" means an entity listed as a client in Kirkland's conflicts search system to whom time was posted in the 12 months preceding the Petition Date. As referenced in <u>Schedule 2</u>, the term "former client" means an entity listed as a client in Kirkland's conflicts search system to whom time was posted between 12 and 36 months preceding the Petition Date. As referenced in <u>Schedule 2</u>, the term "closed client" means an entity listed as a client in Kirkland's conflicts search system to whom time was posted in the 36 months preceding the Petition Date, but for which the client representation has been closed. Whether an actual client relationship exists can only be determined by reference to the documents governing Kirkland's representation rather than its potential listing in Kirkland's conflicts search system. The list generated from Kirkland's conflicts search system is over-inclusive. As a general matter, Kirkland discloses connections with "former clients" or "closed clients" for whom time was posted in the last 36 months, but does not disclose connections if time was billed more than 36 months before the Petition Date.

Kohlberg Kravis Roberts & Co. L.P ("KKR").¹¹ A KKR affiliate is one of the Debtors' contract counterparties. Kirkland has not represented, and will not represent, KKR in connection with any matter in these chapter 11 cases during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. I do not believe that any current or former representation of KKR precludes Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.

- 25. Kirkland's conflicts search of the entities listed on Schedules 1(a) 1(n) (that Kirkland was able to locate using its reasonable efforts) reveals, to the best of my knowledge, that those Kirkland attorneys and paraprofessionals who previously worked at other law firms that represented such entities in these chapter 11 cases have not worked on matters relating to the Debtors' restructuring efforts while at Kirkland.
- 26. Based on the conflicts search conducted to date and described herein, to the best of my knowledge, neither I, Kirkland, nor any partner or associate thereof, insofar as I have been able to ascertain, have any connection with the Debtors, their creditors, or any other parties in interest, their respective attorneys and accountants, the United States Trustee for the Southern District of Texas (the "<u>U.S. Trustee</u>"), any person employed by the U.S. Trustee, or any Bankruptcy Judge currently serving on the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas, except as disclosed or otherwise described herein.
- 27. Kirkland will review its files periodically during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases to ensure that no conflicts or other disqualifying circumstances exist or arise. If any new relevant facts or relationships are discovered or arise, Kirkland will use reasonable efforts to

identify such further developments and will promptly file a supplemental declaration, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 2014(a).

- 28. Generally, it is Kirkland's policy to disclose entities in the capacity that they first appear in a conflicts search. For example, if an entity already has been disclosed in this Declaration in one capacity (e.g., a customer), and the entity appears in a subsequent conflicts search in a different capacity (e.g., a vendor), Kirkland does not disclose the same entity again in supplemental declarations, unless the circumstances are such in the latter capacity that additional disclosure is required.
- 29. From time to time, certain former partners of Kirkland are entitled to compensation for a limited period of time following their departure from the firm.
- 30. From time to time, Kirkland has referred work to other professionals to be retained in these chapter 11 cases. Likewise, certain such professionals have referred work to Kirkland.
- 31. Certain insurance companies pay the legal bills of Kirkland clients. Some of these insurance companies may be involved in these chapter 11 cases. None of these insurance companies, however, are Kirkland clients as a result of the fact that they pay legal fees on behalf of Kirkland clients.

Specific Disclosures

32. As specifically set forth below and in the attached exhibits, Kirkland represents certain of the Debtors' creditors, equity security holders, or other entities that may be parties in interest in ongoing matters unrelated to the Debtors and these chapter 11 cases. None of the representations described herein are materially adverse to the interests of the Debtors' estates. Moreover, pursuant to section 327(c) of the Bankruptcy Code, Kirkland is not disqualified from acting as the Debtors' counsel merely because it represents certain of the Debtors' creditors, equity

security holders, or other entities that may be parties in interest in matters unrelated to these chapter 11 cases.

A. Connections to Financial Counterparties and Certain Other Specified Parties.

- 33. As disclosed on Schedule 2, Kirkland currently represents, and in the past has represented, certain entities that constitute or are affiliated with one or more of the following in a variety of matters: (a) a prepetition lender to the Debtors; (b) an entity with which the Debtors have a banking relationship; or (c) an agent under the Debtors' prepetition credit facilities (collectively, the "Financial Counterparties"). The Financial Counterparties include Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., Credit Suisse AG, Alter Domus Products Corp, and/or their respective affiliates. Kirkland's current and prior representations of the Financial Counterparties are in matters that are unrelated to the Debtors' chapter 11 cases and, except as specifically disclosed in paragraph 34 below, unrelated to the Debtors. Kirkland has not represented and will not represent the Financial Counterparties in connection with any matter in these chapter 11 cases. I do not believe that Kirkland's current or prior representations of the Financial Counterparties preclude Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.
- 34. As disclosed on <u>Schedule 2</u>, Kirkland currently represents, and in the past has represented, affiliates of Deerfield PH Holdings IV LP ("<u>Deerfield IV</u>") and DFP Opco LLC ("<u>DFP</u>") on a variety of matters. Kirkland also previously represented certain DFP affiliates in connection with (a) such entities' initial investment in the Debtors in January 2019 and (b) recapitalizations of the Debtors between December 2019 and July 2021. Kirkland's representations of Deerfield IV and DFP affiliates each accounted for less than one percent of Kirkland's fee receipts for the twelve-month period ending on September 30, 2022. Deerfield IV owns approximately 36.2% and DFP owns approximately 34.4% of the equity interests in Debtor

Pipeline Health System, LLC ("PHS"), the ultimate parent of the other Debtors, and affiliates of Deerfield IV and DFP are lenders under the Debtors' prepetition term loan facility and postpetition term loan facility. Kirkland has not represented and will not represent Deerfield IV or DFP or any of their affiliates (other than the Debtors) in connection with any matter in these chapter 11 cases. Additionally, Kirkland has a waiver from all applicable DFP affiliates for matters related to the Debtors in connection with these chapter 11 cases. The Debtors have also added two disinterested and independent managers, Jonathan Foster and Matthew Ray (the "Disinterested Managers"), to the board of managers of PHS, the Debtors' ultimate parent. In connection with the Debtors' chapter 11 cases, the Debtors are seeking to retain and employ McDonald Hopkins as special counsel to render independent legal services to the Debtors at the sole direction of the Disinterested Managers in connection with any PHS matters in which a conflict of interests exists or is reasonably likely to exist between PHS, on one hand, and any related party of PHS, on the other hand (as determined by the Disinterested Managers). I do not believe that Kirkland's current or prior representations of affiliates of Deerfield IV or affiliates of DFP preclude Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.

B. Other Chapter 11 Professionals.

35. In addition to Kirkland, the Debtors also seek to retain the following professionals in connection with their chapter 11 cases: (a) Jackson Walker LLP, as local and conflicts counsel; (b) McDonald Hopkins, as special counsel; (c) Jefferies LLC, as investment banker; (d) Ankura Consulting Group LLC, as financial advisor; and (e) Deloitte Tax LLP, as tax advisor. As disclosed on <u>Schedule 2</u>, Kirkland currently represents, and in the past has represented, certain affiliates, subsidiaries, and entities associated with certain of these professionals. Kirkland's current and prior representations of these professionals or their related entities have been in matters

unrelated to the Debtors or these chapter 11 cases. Kirkland has not represented, and will not represent, any such professionals or their related entities in connection with any matter in these chapter 11 cases during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. I do not believe that Kirkland's current or prior representation of these professionals or their related entities precludes Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.

C. Connections to Certain Vendors

36. Abbott Laboratories, Agiliti, Inc., Zimmer US Inc., Tenet Healthcare Corporation, Medline Industries Inc., CBRE Inc., Care Continuum Inc., and Cerner Corporation (together with their respective affiliates, collectively, the "Specified Vendors") are vendors of the Debtors. As disclosed on Schedule 2, Kirkland currently represents, and in the past has represented, the Specified Vendors on a variety of matters. Kirkland's current and prior representations of the Specified Vendors have been in matters unrelated to the Debtors or these chapter 11 cases. Kirkland has not represented, and will not represent, the Specified Vendors in connection with any matter in these chapter 11 cases during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. I do not believe that Kirkland's current or prior representations of the Specified Vendors preclude Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.

D. Connections to Other Entities.

37. As disclosed on <u>Schedule 2</u>, Kirkland currently represents, and/or in the past has represented, the State of Illinois and the City of Chicago on a variety of matters. The State of Illinois and the City of Chicago are taxing authorities and regulators of the Debtors. Kirkland's current and/or prior representations of the State of Illinois and the City of Chicago are in matters unrelated to the Debtors or these chapter 11 cases. Kirkland has not represented, and will not represent, the State of Illinois or the City of Chicago in connection with any matter in these chapter

11 cases during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. I do not believe that Kirkland's current and/or prior representations of the State of Illinois or the City of Chicago preclude Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.

E. Potential M&A Transaction Counterparties.

38. The Debtors are in discussions with certain parties (and may be in discussions with other parties in the future) regarding potential M&A transactions regarding the Debtors and their businesses. As disclosed on Schedule 2, Kirkland currently represents, and/or in the past has represented the following potential M&A transaction counterparties or affiliates thereof: Acadia Healthcare Co. Inc., Ardent Health Services, Inc., Ascension Health, CHRISTUS Health, Hilco Real Estate, Mercy Health, Omega Healthcare, ScionHealth, Steward Health Care System, LLC, Summit Behavioral Healthcare, LLC, Tenet Business Services Corp., Tenet Healthcare Corp., Trinity Health, UChicago Medical Center, and Ventas, Inc. Kirkland's current and prior representations of the potential M&A transaction counterparties have been in matters unrelated to the Debtors or these chapter 11 cases. Kirkland has not represented, and will not represent, the potential M&A transaction counterparties in connection with any matter in these chapter 11 cases during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. I do not believe that Kirkland's current or prior representations of the potential M&A transaction counterparties preclude Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.

F. Kirkland Attorney and Employee Investments.

39. From time to time, Kirkland partners, of counsel, associates, and employees personally invest in mutual funds, retirement funds, private equity funds, venture capital funds, hedge funds, and other types of investment funds (the "Investment Funds"), through which such individuals indirectly acquire an interest in debt or equity securities of many companies, one of

which may be one of the Debtors, their creditors, or other parties in interest in these chapter 11 cases, often without Kirkland's knowledge. Each Kirkland person generally owns substantially less than one percent of such Investment Fund, does not manage or otherwise control such Investment Fund, and has no influence over the Investment Fund's decision to buy, sell, or vote any particular security. The Investment Fund is generally operated as a blind pool, meaning that when the Kirkland persons make an investment in the Investment Fund, he, she, or they do not know what securities the blind pool Investment Fund will purchase or sell, and have no control over such purchases or sales.

40. From time to time one or more Kirkland partners and of counsel voluntarily choose to form an entity (a "Passive-Intermediary Entity") to invest in one or more Investment Funds. Such Passive-Intermediary Entity is composed only of persons who were Kirkland partners and of counsel at the time of the Passive-Intermediary Entity's formation (although some may later become former Kirkland partners and of counsel). Participation in such a Passive-Intermediary Entity is wholly voluntary and only a portion of Kirkland's partners and of counsel choose to participate. The Passive-Intermediary Entity generally owns substantially less than one percent of any such Investment Fund, does not manage or otherwise control such Investment Fund, and has no influence over the Investment Fund's decision to buy, sell, or vote any particular security. Each Investment Fund in which a Passive-Intermediary Entity invests is operated as a blind pool, so that the Passive-Intermediary Entity does not know what securities the blind pool Investment Funds will purchase or sell, and has no control over such purchases or sales. And, indeed, the Passive-Intermediary Entity often arranges for statements and communications from certain Investment Funds to be sent solely to a blind administrator who edits out all information regarding the identity of the Investment Fund's underlying investments, so that the Passive-Intermediary

Entity does not learn (even after the fact) the identity of the securities purchased, sold, or held by the Investment Fund. To the extent the Passive-Intermediary Entity is or becomes aware of the identity of the securities purchased, sold, or held by the Investment Funds ("Known Holdings"), such Known Holdings are submitted to Kirkland's conflict checking system.

41. From time to time, Kirkland partners, of counsel, associates, and employees personally directly acquire a debt or equity security of a company which may be (or become) one of the Debtors, their creditors, or other parties in interest in these chapter 11 cases. Kirkland has a long-standing policy prohibiting attorneys and employees from using confidential information that may come to their attention in the course of their work, so that all Kirkland attorneys and employees are barred from trading in securities with respect to which they possess confidential information.

G. Other Disclosures.

- 42. Finally, certain interrelationships exist among the Debtors. Nevertheless, the Debtors have advised Kirkland that the Debtors' relationships to each other do not pose any conflict of interest because of the general unity of interest among the Debtors. Insofar as I have been able to ascertain, I know of no conflict of interest that would preclude Kirkland's joint representation of the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases.
- 43. Jamie Botter, a Kirkland non-attorney employee, is the daughter of David H. Botter, a partner of Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld LLP, proposed counsel to the Committee. I do not believe that this connection precludes Kirkland from meeting the disinterestedness standard under the Bankruptcy Code.
- 44. Furthermore, prior to joining Kirkland, certain Kirkland attorneys represented clients adverse to Kirkland's current and former restructuring clients. Certain of these attorneys

(the "Screened Kirkland Attorneys") will not perform work in connection with Kirkland's representation of the Debtors and will not have access to confidential information related to the representation. Kirkland's formal ethical screen provides sufficient safeguards and procedures to prevent imputation of conflicts by isolating the Screened Kirkland Attorneys and protecting confidential information.

45. Under Kirkland's screening procedures, Kirkland's conflicts department distributes a memorandum to all Kirkland attorneys and legal assistants directing them as follows: (a) not to discuss any aspects of Kirkland's representation of the Debtors with the Screened Kirkland Attorneys; (b) to conduct meetings, phone conferences, and other communications regarding Kirkland's representation of the Debtors in a manner that avoids contact with the Screened Kirkland Attorneys; (c) to take all measures necessary or appropriate to prevent access by the Screened Kirkland Attorneys to the files or other information related to Kirkland's representation of the Debtors; and (d) to avoid contact between the Screened Kirkland Attorneys and all Kirkland personnel working on the representation of the Debtors unless there is a clear understanding that there will be no discussion of any aspects of Kirkland's representation of the Debtors. Furthermore, Kirkland already has implemented procedures to block the Screened Kirkland Attorneys from accessing files and documents related to the Debtors that are stored in Kirkland's electronic document managing system.

Affirmative Statement of Disinterestedness

46. Based on the conflicts search conducted to date and described herein, to the best of my knowledge and insofar as I have been able to ascertain, (a) Kirkland is a "disinterested person" within the meaning of section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code, as required by section 327(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, and does not hold or represent an interest adverse to the Debtors' estates

and (b) Kirkland has no connection to the Debtors, their creditors, or other parties in interest, except as may be disclosed herein.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
