

NOTICE OF DEADLINES FOR FILING OF PROOFS OF CLAIM (OTHER THAN WITH RESPECT TO ASBESTOS PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMS)

GENERAL BAR DATE IS JANUARY 13, 2023 AT 5:00 P.M., PREVAILING EASTERN TIME

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING:

On November 2, 2022, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina (the "Court") entered an order (Dkt. 1628) (the "Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order") establishing certain deadlines for the filing of proofs of claim in the above-captioned chapter 11 case of DBMP LLC (the "Debtor"). For the avoidance of doubt, the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order does not extend or modify the bar date for "Pending Mesothelioma Claims," as defined and described in the Order (i) Establishing a Bar Date for Pending Mesothelioma Claims, (ii) Approving Proof of Claim Form, (iii) Approving Notice to Claimants, and (iv) Directing Submission of Personal Injury Questionnaires by Pending Mesothelioma Claimants (Dkt. 1461) (the "Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order"). The bar date for Pending Mesothelioma Claims has passed; it was (and remains) September 12, 2022.

Electronic copies of all documents filed in the Debtor's chapter 11 case, including the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order, may be obtained free of charge at <https://dm.epiq11.com/DBMP> or for a fee on the Court's website, <http://ecf.ncwb.us/court.gov>.

By the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order, the Court established January 13, 2023 at 5:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern Time (the "General Bar Date"), as the general deadline for all Entities, including Governmental Units (both defined herein), to file proofs of claim in the Debtor's chapter 11 case for all claims against the Debtor that arose or are deemed to have arisen prior to January 23, 2020, including claims arising under section 503(b)(9) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), except as otherwise provided in the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order and expressly excluding Pending Mesothelioma Claims and other Asbestos Claims (both as defined below). As described therein, the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order also establishes different bar dates for certain categories of claims.

Except as provided herein, the General Bar Date applies to all General Claims against the Debtor. Please review the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order for instructions on how to file a proof of claim in the Debtor's chapter 11 case. All proofs of claim must be received by the applicable Non-Asbestos Bar Date in order to be accepted as timely.

KEY DEFINITIONS

As used in this Notice, the term "General Claim" shall mean any Claim that arose, or is deemed to have arisen prior to January 23, 2020, other than a Pending Mesothelioma Claim or any other Asbestos Claim.

As used in this Notice and as set forth in the Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order, the term "Pending Mesothelioma Claim" means a mesothelioma claim against the Debtor by a person who asserted a mesothelioma claim against the Debtor or its predecessors (including the former CertainTeed Corporation) prior to January 23, 2020, relating in any way to asbestos or asbestos-containing products for which the Debtor or its predecessors-in-interest (including CertainTeed Corporation) are alleged to be responsible; provided, however, that Pending Mesothelioma Claims shall not include asbestos-related mesothelioma claims against the Debtor or its predecessors (1) that have been dismissed with prejudice or settled and paid, (2) are known to be time-barred, or (3) for which the exclusive remedy is provided under workers' compensation statutes and similar laws. Please note that the deadline for filing a Pending Mesothelioma Claim was September 12, 2022 and has not been modified or extended by the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order.

As used in this Notice, the term "Asbestos Claim" means any claim (as defined in section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code) for costs or damages, including with respect to bodily injury, death, sickness, disease, emotional distress, fear of cancer, medical monitoring or other personal injuries (whether physical, emotional or otherwise), for which the Debtor is alleged to be liable, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, based upon, arising out of or relating to the presence of or exposure to asbestos or asbestos-containing products, including, without limitation: (a) any products previously designed, marketed, manufactured, fabricated, constructed, sold, supplied, shipped, transported, produced, installed, maintained, serviced, specified, selected, repaired, removed, replaced, released, distributed or in any other way made available by any predecessors to the Debtor; or (b) any materials present at any premises owned, leased, occupied or operated by any entity for whose products, acts, omissions, business or operations the Debtor has, or is alleged to have, liability. Asbestos Claims include all such claims (including Pending Mesothelioma Claims), whether: (a) in tort, contract, warranty, restitution, conspiracy, contribution, indemnity, guarantee, subrogation or any other theory of law, equity or admiralty; (b) seeking compensatory, special, economic, non-economic, punitive, exemplary, administrative or any other costs or damages; or (c) seeking any legal, equitable or other relief of any kind whatsoever. Asbestos Claims also include any such claims that have been resolved or are subject to resolution pursuant to any agreement, or any such claims that are based on a judgment or verdict. Asbestos Claims do not include (a) any claim of an insurer with respect to amounts allegedly due under any insurance policies, including policies that might have provided coverage for Asbestos Claims; or (b) any claim by any present or former employee of a predecessor or affiliate of the Debtor for benefits under a policy of workers' compensation insurance or for benefits under any state or federal workers' compensation statute or other statute providing compensation to an employee from an employer. Please note that no deadline has been established at this time for the filing of Asbestos Claims other than Pending Mesothelioma Claims subject to the Mesothelioma Bar Date Order.

As used in this Notice, the terms "Entity," "Governmental Unit," "affiliate" and "Claim" or "claim" have the meanings given to them under section 101 of the Bankruptcy Code.

WHO MUST FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM

The following Entities must file proofs of claim on or before the General Bar Date: (a) any Entity (i) whose prepetition General Claim against the Debtor is not listed in the Debtor's schedules of assets and liabilities or statement of financial affairs (Dkts. 185, 186, 405) (collectively, as amended, the "Schedules") or is listed as "disputed," "contingent" or "unliquidated" and (ii) that desires to share in any distribution in the chapter 11 case; (b) any Entity that (i) believes its prepetition General Claim is improperly classified in the Schedules or is listed in an incorrect amount and (ii) desires to have its prepetition General Claim allowed in a classification or amount other than that identified in the Schedules; and (c) for the avoidance of doubt and without limiting the foregoing, any entity asserting an administrative priority claim under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code for the value of goods received by the Debtor within 20 days prior to the Petition Date. If it is unclear from the Schedules whether your prepetition General Claim is disputed, contingent or unliquidated as to amount or is otherwise properly listed and classified, you must file a proof of claim on or before the applicable Non-Asbestos Bar Date. Any Entity that relies on the information in the Schedules bears responsibility for determining that its General Claim is accurately listed therein.

PROOFS OF CLAIM NOT REQUIRED TO BE FILED BY THE GENERAL BAR DATE

The Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order further provides that the following Entities need not file proofs of claim by the General Bar Date: (a) any Entity holding or asserting a Pending Mesothelioma Claim or any other Asbestos Claim; (b) any Entity that already has properly filed a proof of claim against the Debtor in accordance with (i) the procedures described in the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order or (ii) Rule 3001-1 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina; (c) any Entity (i) whose General Claim against the Debtor is not listed as disputed, contingent or unliquidated in the Schedules and (ii) that agrees with the nature, classification and amount of its General Claim as identified in the Schedules; (d) any Entity whose claim against the Debtor previously has been allowed by, or paid pursuant to, an order of the Court; and (e) any Entity holding or asserting an administrative expense claim against the Debtor under sections 503(b) and 507(a)(2) of the Bankruptcy Code, except that any administrative priority claims under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code must be filed by the General Bar Date.

As noted, Pending Mesothelioma Claims remain subject to the bar date established by the Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order, which was September 12, 2022. Nothing herein extends or otherwise modifies the bar date for Pending Mesothelioma Claims as set forth in the Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order.

CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM BY THE APPLICABLE NON-ASBESTOS BAR DATE

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE ORDERED BY THE COURT, ANY ENTITY THAT IS REQUIRED TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM WITH RESPECT TO A PARTICULAR CLAIM AGAINST THE DEBTOR BUT THAT FAILS TO DO SO BY THE APPLICABLE NON-ASBESTOS BAR DATE DESCRIBED IN THIS NOTICE OR THE NON-ASBESTOS BAR DATE ORDER SHALL BE FOREVER BARRED, ESTOPPED AND ENJOINED FROM THE FOLLOWING: (A) ASSERTING ANY SUCH CLAIM AGAINST THE DEBTOR OR ITS ESTATE OR PROPERTY THAT (i) IS IN AN AMOUNT THAT EXCEEDS THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, THAT IS IDENTIFIED IN THE SCHEDULES ON BEHALF OF SUCH ENTITY AS UNDISPUTED, NON-CONTINGENT AND LIQUIDATED OR (ii) IS OF A DIFFERENT NATURE OR CLASSIFICATION THAN ANY SUCH CLAIM IDENTIFIED IN THE SCHEDULES ON BEHALF OF SUCH ENTITY (ANY SUCH CLAIM IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (A) BEING REFERRED TO IN THIS NOTICE AS AN "UNSCHEDULED CLAIM"); OR (B) VOTING ON, OR RECEIVING DISTRIBUTIONS UNDER, ANY CHAPTER 11 PLAN IN THE DEBTOR'S CHAPTER 11 CASE IN RESPECT OF AN UNSCHEDULED CLAIM.

HAWKS CLOSER THAN A COURTSIDE SEAT

Hawks’ City Edition uniforms pay respect to state, mantra

Hawks fans finally got a look at this season’s Nike City Edition jerseys Thursday night, when they debuted in the game against the 76ers at State Farm Arena.

The Hawks used elements from the Peachtree City Edition uniform from three years ago to create a new take. The team’s hope was that this season’s City Edition uniform will pay respect to the state of Georgia, while living up to the Hawks’ mantra of being “True To Atlanta.”

“The narrative that really originated with us, is that the first Peachtree City Edition from I think 2019 was such a huge hit that instead of rewriting the story, and rewriting the narrative, we were super excited to bring it back,” said Shirley Zhang, Hawks vice president of brand creative.

“If we could have done it sooner, we would have done it sooner. And so it takes about three years to go from concept to, to the product and launching it.”

So, the Hawks went with a black base that incorpo-

rated hues of “Electro Peach” and “Sunset Haze.” The team described Electro Peach as a “not-so-ordinary peach hue, which serves as a representation for the high energy of the city that it proudly calls home. Sunset Haze is a nod to the home in Georgia.”

The Hawks then used both peach hues to create a gradient spectrum on the numbers of each jersey.

The letters of the word “Atlanta” are stylized in a modern athletic script said to be inspired by the city and a nod to the city as the global center for arts, culture and entertainment. The traditional jersey trim at the neck and arms is configured in Electro Peach and Sunset Haze.

On the shorts, the traditional trim from the jersey extends to the striping on them. The team also includes a peach in the form of the bas-



ketball on the midpoint of the uniform at the belt buckle.

“In 2019, when we went hard with black uniform and pops a peach, it really gave us a vibe and an edge from a player-feedback perspective,” Zhang said. “And that really resonated with us. In turn you saw some of the feedback implemented afterwards with you know, our MLK City Edition and so on, so forth. So that was a huge piece of the puzzle that I think really helped us build forward.”

In addition to the jerseys, the Hawks unveiled a new court Thursday night that will complement the jersey.

The team will wear the City Edition uniforms 10 times.

Hughes (6A), Ware County (5A), Cedartown (4A), Cedar Grove (3A), Fitzgerald (2A), Prince Avenue Christian (A Division I) and Bowdon (A Division II). Buford, Cedar Grove and Fitzgerald won titles last year. Bowdon last won in 1992, Cedartown in 1963. Hughes and Ware County have never won.

Regulars: Six schools have made the playoffs each season this century. They are Buford, Calhoun, Commerce, Cook, Fitzgerald, Marist and Peach County. Thirty-eight schools have made the playoffs 10 consecutive seasons or more. Almost all made it this year with room to spare, but Jefferson County saved its 21-year streak last week with a 47-41 double-overtime victory over East Laurens.

Newbies: Coahulla Creek is the only team making the playoffs for the first time. The Whitfield County school played its first varsity season in 2012, and the Colts’ 7-3 record represents the program’s first winning season. Teams breaking long droughts are Lanier County (last appearance in 2005), Chamblee (2009), East Jackson (2009), Bacon County (2014), Lumpkin County

(2014), Bryan County (2015) and Shaw (2015).

Just missed: Collins Hill, the Class 7A champion, failed to return to the playoffs. The Eagles are the first defending champion to miss since Hawkinsville in 2015 and the first in the highest class since Lowndes in 2006. Class 7A was unkind to traditional powers. McEachern, a regular since 2009, and Archer, whose playoff streak dates to 2013, also missed qualifying.

Beating odds: From a preseason perspective, the most surprising playoff team is Lumpkin County, given only a 1.5% chance of qualifying out of Region 7-3A by the computer Maxwell Ratings. The Indians were 7-43

over the previous five seasons, but are 8-2 in Heath Webb’s first year as coach and seeded No. 2. This is their first playoff appearance since 2014. Other successful long shots were Morrow (2.4%), Paulding County (5.1%), Walnut Grove (6.3%), Greene County (8.5%) and ACE Charter (9.5%).

Best first-round games: Five games match top-10 teams, two involving reigning champions Benedictine and Brooks County. The five are No. 8 Valdosta at No. 10 Westlake in Class 7A, No. 10 Houston County at No. 8 Brunswick in 6A, No. 10 Whitewater at No. 4 Benedictine and No. 8 Burke County at No. 10 LaGrange in 4A, and No. 10 Bleckley County at No. 10 Brooks County in A Division I.

Hardest to pick: The Maxwell Ratings peg five games as near toss-ups. The one-point favorites are Douglas County (over Allatoona), LaGrange (over Burke County), Telfair County (over ECI), Trion (over Commerce) and Westminster (over Lovett).

What’s next: The second round is next week. If all favored teams advance, the rounds of 16 should be especially interesting in Class 7A, where No. 3 Mill Creek would play at No. 5 North Cobb, and No. 6 Walton would play at No. 1 Buford.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING:

On November 2, 2022, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina (the “Court”) entered an order (Dkt. 1628) (the “Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order”) establishing certain deadlines for the filing of proofs of claim in the above-captioned chapter 11 case of DBMP LLC (the “Debtor”). For the avoidance of doubt, the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order does not extend or modify the bar date for “Pending Mesothelioma Claims,” as defined and described in the Order (I) Establishing a Bar Date for Pending Mesothelioma Claims, (II) Approving Proof of Claim Form, (III) Approving Notice to Claimants, and (IV) Directing Submission of Personal Injury Questionnaires by Pending Mesothelioma Claimants (Dkt. 1461) (the “Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order”). The bar date for Pending Mesothelioma Claims has passed; it and (remains) September 12, 2022.

Electronic copies of all documents filed in the Debtor’s chapter 11 case, including the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order, may be obtained free of charge at <https://dm.epiq11.com/DBMP> or for a fee on the Court’s website, <http://ecf.ncwb.us/courts.gov>.

By the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order, the Court established **January 13, 2023 at 5:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern Time** (the “General Bar Date”), as the general deadline for all Entities, including Governmental Units (both defined herein), to file proofs of claim in the Debtor’s chapter 11 case for all claims against the Debtor that arose or are deemed to have arisen prior to January 23, 2020, including claims arising under section 503(b)(9) of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”), except as otherwise provided in the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order and expressly excluding Pending Mesothelioma Claims and other Asbestos Claims (both as defined below). As described therein, the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order also establishes different bar dates for certain categories of claims.

Except as provided herein, the General Bar Date applies to all General Claims against the Debtor. **Please review the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order for instructions on how to file a proof of claim in the Debtor’s chapter 11 case.** All proofs of claim must be received by the applicable Non-Asbestos Bar Date in order to be accepted as timely.

KEY DEFINITIONS

As used in this Notice, the term “General Claim” shall mean any Claim that arose, or is deemed to have arisen prior to January 23, 2020, other than a Pending Mesothelioma Claim or any other Asbestos Claim.

As used in this Notice and as set forth in the Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order, the term “Pending Mesothelioma Claim” means a mesothelioma claim against the Debtor by a person who asserted a mesothelioma claim against the Debtor or its predecessors (including the former Certainfeed Corporation) prior to January 23, 2020, relating in any way to asbestos or asbestos-containing products for which the Debtor or its predecessors-in-interest (including Certainfeed Corporation) are alleged to be responsible; provided, however, that Pending Mesothelioma Claims shall not include asbestos-related mesothelioma claims against the Debtor or its predecessors (1) that have been dismissed with prejudice or settled and paid, (2) are known to be time-barred, or (3) for which the exclusive remedy is provided under workers’ compensation statutes and similar laws. **Please note that the deadline for filing a Pending Mesothelioma Claim was September 12, 2022 and has not been modified or extended by the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order.**

As used in this Notice, the term “Asbestos Claim” means any claim (as defined in section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code) for costs or damages, including with respect to bodily injury, death, sickness, disease, emotional distress, fear of cancer, medical monitoring or other personal injuries (whether physical, emotional or otherwise), for which the Debtor is alleged to be liable, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, based upon, arising out of or relating to the presence of or exposure to asbestos or asbestos-containing products, including, without limitation: (a) any products previously designed, marketed, manufactured, fabricated, constructed, sold, supplied, shipped, transported, produced, installed, maintained, serviced, specified, selected, repaired, removed, replaced, released, distributed or in any other way made available by any predecessors to the Debtor; or (b) any materials present at any premises owned, leased, occupied or operated by any entity for whose products, acts, omissions, business or operations the Debtor has, or is alleged to have, liability. Asbestos Claims include all such claims (including Pending Mesothelioma Claims), whether: (a) in tort, contract, warranty, restitution, conspiracy, contribution, indemnity, guarantee, subrogation or any other theory of law, equity or admiralty; (b) seeking compensatory, special, economic, non-economic, punitive, exemplary, administrative or any other costs or damages; or (c) seeking any legal, equitable or other relief of any kind whatsoever. Asbestos Claims also include any such claims that have been resolved or are subject to resolution pursuant to any agreement, or any such claims that are based on a judgment or verdict. Asbestos Claims do not include (a) any claim of an insurer with respect to amounts allegedly due under any insurance policies, including policies that might have provided coverage for Asbestos Claims; or (b) any claim by any present or former employee of a predecessor or affiliate of the Debtor for benefits under a policy of workers’ compensation insurance or for benefits under any state or federal workers’ compensation statute or other statute providing compensation to an employee from an employer. **Please note that no deadline has been established at this time for the filing of Asbestos Claims other than Pending Mesothelioma Claims subject to the Mesothelioma Bar Date Order.**

As used in this Notice, the terms “Entity,” “Governmental Unit,” “affiliate” and “Claim” or “claim” have the meanings given to them under section 101 of the Bankruptcy Code.

WHO MUST FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM

The following Entities must file proofs of claim on or before the General Bar Date: (a) any Entity (i) whose prepetition General Claim against the Debtor is not listed in the Debtor’s schedules of assets and liabilities or statement of financial affairs (Dkts. 185, 186, 405) (collectively, the “Schedules”) or is listed as “disputed,” “contingent” or “unliquidated”; and (ii) that desires to share in any distribution in the chapter 11 case; (b) any Entity (i) that believes its prepetition General Claim is improperly classified in the Schedules or is listed in an incorrect amount and (ii) desires to have its prepetition General Claim allowed in a classification or amount other than that identified in the Schedules; and (c) for the avoidance of doubt and without limiting the foregoing, any entity asserting an administrative priority claim under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code for the value of goods received by the Debtor within 20 days prior to the Petition Date. If it is unclear from the Schedules whether your prepetition General Claim is disputed, contingent or unliquidated as to amount or is otherwise properly listed and classified, you must file a proof of claim on or before the applicable Non-Asbestos Bar Date. Any Entity that relies on the information in the Schedules bears responsibility for determining that its General Claim is accurately listed therein.

PROOFS OF CLAIM NOT REQUIRED TO BE FILED BY THE GENERAL BAR DATE

The Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order further provides that the following Entities need not file proofs of claim by the General Bar Date: (a) any Entity holding or asserting a Pending Mesothelioma Claim or any other Asbestos Claim; (b) any Entity that already has properly filed a proof of claim against the Debtor in accordance with (i) the procedures described in the Non-Asbestos Bar Date Order or (ii) Rule 3001-1 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina; (c) any Entity (i) whose General Claim against the Debtor is not listed as disputed, contingent or unliquidated in the Schedules and (ii) that agrees with the nature, classification and amount of its General Claim identified in the Schedules; (d) any Entity whose claim against the Debtor previously has been allowed by, or paid pursuant to, an order of the Court; and (e) any Entity holding or asserting an administrative expense claim against the Debtor under sections 503(b) and 507(a)(2) of the Bankruptcy Code, except that any administrative priority claims under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code must be filed by the General Bar Date.

As noted, Pending Mesothelioma Claims remain subject to the bar date established by the Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order, which was September 12, 2022. Nothing herein extends or otherwise modifies the bar date for Pending Mesothelioma Claims as set forth in the Mesothelioma Claims Bar Date Order.

CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM BY THE APPLICABLE NON-ASBESTOS BAR DATE

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE ORDERED BY THE COURT, ANY ENTITY THAT IS REQUIRED TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM WITH RESPECT TO A PARTICULAR CLAIM AGAINST THE DEBTOR BUT THAT FAILS TO DO SO BY THE APPLICABLE NON-ASBESTOS BAR DATE DESCRIBED IN THIS NOTICE OR THE NON-ASBESTOS BAR DATE ORDER SHALL BE FOREVER BARRED, ESTOPPED AND ENJOINED FROM FOLLOWING: (A) ASSERTING ANY SUCH CLAIM AGAINST THE DEBTOR OR ITS ESTATE OR PROPERTY THAT (I) IS IN AN AMOUNT THAT EXCEEDS THE AMOUNT, IF ANY, THAT IS IDENTIFIED IN THE SCHEDULES ON BEHALF OF SUCH ENTITY AS UNDISPUTED, NONCONTINGENT AND LIQUIDATED OR (II) IS OF A DIFFERENT NATURE OR CLASSIFICATION THAN ANY SUCH CLAIM IDENTIFIED IN THE SCHEDULES ON BEHALF OF SUCH ENTITY (ANY SUCH CLAIM IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (A) BEING REFERRED TO IN THIS NOTICE AS AN “UNSCHEDULED CLAIM”); OR (B) VOTING ON, OR RECEIVING DISTRIBUTIONS UNDER, ANY CHAPTER 11 PLAN IN THE DEBTOR’S CHAPTER 11 CASE IN RESPECT OF AN UNSCHEDULED CLAIM.
