**ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR'S MOTION
FOR AUTHORITY TO MODIFY CORPORATION NAME**
(Relates to Docket No. 197)

Upon the motion (the "**Motion**")² of the Debtor for an order (the "**Order**") under Section 105(a) of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "**Bankruptcy Code**") and applicable non-bankruptcy laws for authority to change the Debtor's name and caption of this case, all as set forth in the Motion; the Court finds that (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334(b); (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); (iii) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interest of the Debtor, its estate,

and its creditors; (iv) proper and adequate notice of the Motion and the hearing for the Motion has been given; (v) no other or further notice is necessary; and (vi) the record for the Motion, after due deliberation, provides good and sufficient cause for granting the Motion. Therefore, the Court ORDERS that:

1. The Debtor is authorized to take all necessary steps to effectuate the name change from “Navarro Pecan Company, Inc.,” to “NOC, Inc.” (or a similar name as approved by the Texas Secretary of State). A duly appointed officer, director, or manager of the Debtor is authorized to execute and cause the filing of any documents necessary to effectuate such change with the Office of the Texas Secretary of State.

2. The name and caption of the Debtor’s Chapter 11 case shall be changed to read as follows:

3. The Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court is directed to make a docket entry in case number 23-40266-elm11 substantially as follows: “An order has been entered in this case directing the caption of this case be changed in accordance with the corporate name change of Navarro Pecan Company, Inc., to NOC, INC.”

4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation of this Order.

5. The Debtor is authorized to take any actions necessary to implement this Order.
