AGREED ORDER GRANTING UNCONTESTED MOTION
FOR RELIEF FROM AUTOMATIC STAY

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the *Uncontested Motion for Relief from Automatic Stay* [Dkt #540] (the “**Motion**”) filed by Derek Henderson, Chapter 11 trustee (“**Trustee**”) for the above-captioned debtors in these jointly administered cases (collectively, the “**Debtors**”) pursuant to § 362 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Court, being advised in the premises and that the Trustee is informed of and consents to the relief requested in the Motion, finds the same to be well-taken and that it should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion is granted, and the automatic stay of § 362 of the Bankruptcy Code is hereby modified to permit Julio Cesar Yepez Suarez to pursue that certain civil claim against UFI Transportation LLC (“UFIT”) and Ruben Daniel Alcala who while allegedly within the course and scope of his employment with UFIT was involved in a vehicle accident with Julio Cesar Yepez Suarez, (“Suarez”) in the State of Nevada. Suarez alleges that the accident was Alcala’s fault. Julio Cesar Yepez Suarez, shall be entitled to pursue all claims to final resolution and to collect from and against any responsible non-debtor parties, including liability insurance carriers, upon his claim becoming final and enforceable, and Plaintiff agrees that any claim for amounts remaining owed after exhaustion of collection from such non-debtor parties are waived and shall not be asserted against the estate.
