AMENDED ORDER AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF PORZIO, BROMBERG & NEWMAN, P.C., TOGETHER WITH ITS WHOLLY OWNED SUBSIDIARY PORZIO, BROMBERG & NEWMAN (PR), LLC, AS COUNSEL FOR THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS OF GRUPO HIMA SAN PABLO, INC.; CENTRO MEDICO EL TURABO, INC.; HIMA SAN PABLO PROPERTIES, INC.; PORTAL DE CAGUAS, INC.; GENERAL CONTRACTING SERVICES, INC.; IA DEVELOPERS, CORP.; CMT DEVELOPMENT, LLC.; JOCAR, INC.; JERUSALEM HOME AMBULANCE, INC.; AND HOST SECURITY SERVICES, INC.

This matter having been brought before the Court by the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") in the above-captioned cases, upon application (the "Application") for entry of an order (this "Order") pursuant to section 1103(a) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), Rule 2014(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), and Rule 2014-1 of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Puerto Rico (the "Local Rules"), authorizing the *nunc pro tunc* employment and retention of Porzio, Bromberg & Newman, P.C., together with its wholly owned subsidiary Porzio, Bromberg & Newman, (PR), LLC (together,

"Porzio"), as counsel for the Committee, effective as of September 15, 2023, and also upon the *Notice Regarding Amended Proposed Order Authorizing the Retention of Porzio, Bromberg & Newman, P.C., Together with its Wholly Owned Subsidiary, Porzio, Bromberg & Newman (PR), LLC, as Counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Grupo HIMA San Pablo, Inc.; Centro Medico El Turabo, Inc.; HIMA San Pablo Properties, Inc.; Portal De Caguas, Inc.; General Contracting Services, Inc.; IA Developers, Corp.; CMT Development, LLC.; Jocar, Inc.; Jerusalem Home Ambulance, Inc.; and Host Security Services, Inc.*, filed on October 20, 2023; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Application and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and the consideration of the Application and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and the Court having considered the Application, the accompanying declaration of Francisco E. Colón-Ramírez, Esq. in Support of Application for Order Authorizing the Retention of Porzio, Bromberg & Newman, P.C., together with its Wholly Owned Subsidiary Porzio, Bromberg & Newman (PR), LLC, as Counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of GRUPO HIMA SAN PABLO, INC.; CENTRO MEDICO EL TURABO, INC.; HIMA SAN PABLO PROPERTIES, INC.; PORTAL DE CAGUAS, INC.; GENERAL CONTRACTING SERVICES, INC.; IA DVELOPERS, CORP.; CMT DEVELOPMENT, LLC.; JOCAR, INC.; JERUSALEM HOME AMBULANCE, INC.; AND HOST SECURITY SERVICES, INC., and all responses or objections to the Application; and the Court being satisfied that Porzio is a disinterested person and does not hold or represent an interest adverse to the estates with respect to any of the matters for which Porzio is to be engaged; and the Court finding that the employment of Porzio is necessary to the performance of the Committee's duties; and notice of this Order having been given to all

parties entitled to receive notice; and it appearing that no other notice need be given; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Application is **GRANTED** as set forth therein; and it is further

ORDERED, that Porzio is hereby authorized to represent the Committee *nunc pro tunc* as of September 15, 2023, the date on which the Committee selected Porzio as its counsel; and it is further

ORDERED, that Porzio shall receive compensation for its services and reimbursement for its expenses, upon application and subject to approval by the Court pursuant to Bankruptcy Code sections 330 and 331, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules and any future orders of this Court; and it is further

ORDERED, that Porzio shall have the same treatment as Debtors' professionals in relation to billing and compensation procedures as follows:


- a. Applicant will invoice Debtors on a monthly basis, with a copy of the monthly invoice being filed with the Honorable Court;
- b. Applicant shall transmit by email the billing statement to the United States Trustee, the Debtors, counsel for any creditor holding or asserting a claim secured by cash collateral, and any such other parties as the Court may direct in the future;
- c. Parties receiving billing statements will have fourteen (14) days from the date of transmission within which to notify Applicant by email about objections to payment of fees or expenses included in the billing statement. Such written objections shall identify the time or expense objected to and shall state the reason(s) for such objection;

- d. If written objections to the billing statement are received by Applicant within fourteen (14) days from transmittal, then Applicant shall file a motion with the court within three (3) days of receipt submitting such objection. If no such written objection is received, the Applicant shall file a "Certificate of No Objection" with the court within three (3) days of the lapse of the fourteen (14) day objection period and 80% of the billing statement will thereafter be paid by the Debtors. If a specific written objection to the billing statement was timely asserted and not resolved, then Debtors will pay the undisputed amount of the billing statement, not to exceed 80% of the total billing statement. The portion of the fees or expenses which were objected to will not be paid unless the Court directs such payment or until such objection is resolved; and
- e. Every four months, the law firm will file an interim compensation in accordance with section 331 of the Bankruptcy Code with the Honorable Court and upon the Order by the Court, will be entitled to collect the remaining 20% to the extent allowed by the Court.

and it is further

ORDERED, that the Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from the interpretation or implementation of this Order.
