The Municipal Service Review evaluates the District's operations across eight categories. The areas that are the subject of the sphere of influence amendment consist of territory currently served by the Monte Rio Fire Protection District and the City of Sebastopol's Fire Department.

The reason for the proposed sphere amendment is to allow the subject territories to be eligible for annexation to the Gold Ridge Fire Protection District, and thereby to receive fire and emergency medical services from the District. Reorganizations involving the proposed annexations will be considered only if the sphere of influence of the District is amended as proposed.

At the hearing, LAFCO will consider any relevant oral or written testimony and evidence presented or filed regarding the determinations of the Municipal Service Review and the proposed sphere amendment.

On October 21, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as it can be heard, the City Council will consider adoption of this ordinance to approve an amendment to the Development Agreement by and between the City of Healdsburg and Replay Healdsburg, LLC for the Mill District Project.
