OBJECTION TO ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIM
[CLAIM NO. 10092 - Vantage Logistics Corporation]

COMES NOW Derek Henderson, duly appointed liquidating trustee of the UFI Liquidating Trust (“**Liquidating Trustee**”), and files this *Objection to Administrative Claim [Claim No. 10092 - Vantage Logistics Corporation]* (the “**Claim**”). In support of this Objection, the Liquidating Trustee shows as follows:

1. By order of the Court [Dkt #826], an Administrative Bar Date of November 30, 2023, was established by which all administrative claims must be filed.
2. Vantage Logistics filed its Claim on April 26, 2023, as Claim No. 10092.²
3. The Liquidating Trustee objects to the Claim on the following grounds:

- Claim should be reclassified (Class 6 Unsecured)
- Claim asserted under § 503(b)(9) but does not qualify (no goods sold, goods not delivered within 20 days of petition date)
- Claim not allowable in whole or in part under § 503(b)(1) as administrative expense
- Claim unsupported by documents or explanation or is otherwise undeterminable

4. On the foregoing bases, the Claim should be disallowed as an administrative expense. Subject to proof of liquidation, validity and documentary support, the Claim may be reclassified as an allowed claim under Class 6 in an amount to be proven.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidating Trustee requests that the Court sustain his Objection and disallow the Claim as an administrative expense. The Liquidating Trustee requests such other relief that the Court deems necessary and just.
