ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY MOTION OF CITIZENS BANK, N.A. FOR AN ORDER (I) DESIGNATING AN OFFICER OF THE DEBTOR TO COMPLETE THE SALE PROCESS AND MANAGE THE DEBTOR, (II) DIRECTING NIRMAL MULYE TO CEASE EXERCISING ANY CONTROL OR AUTHORITY OF THE DEBTOR, (III) DIRECTING NIRMAL MULYE TO CEASE INTERFERENCE WITH THE SALE PROCESS, (IV) COMPELLING THE DEBTOR TO CONSUMMATE THE SALE OF ITS ASSETS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE APPLICABLE ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENTS AND THE APPLICABLE SALE ORDERS, AND (V) PROVIDING FOR A FURTHER HEARING

Upon the motion [Docket No. 381] of Citizens Bank, N.A. ("<u>Citizens</u>"), to compel the Debtor to (I) Designate an Officer of the Debtor to Complete the Sale Process and Manage the Debtor, (II) Directing Nirmal Mulye to Cease Exercising Any Control or Authority of the Debtor, (III) Directing Nirmal Mulye to Cease Interference With the Sale Process, and (IV) Compelling the Debtor to Consummate the Sale of its Assets in Accordance With the Terms of the Applicable Asset Purchase Agreements and the Applicable Sale Orders (the "Motion"), and upon consideration of any response received thereto; and the Court having conducted a hearing on the Motion on an emergent basis, at which time all interested parties were offered an opportunity to be heard with respect to the Motion; and the Court having reviewed and considered the Motion and, if any, any objections thereto; and the Court having heard statements of counsel and the evidence presented in support of the relief set forth in the Motion; and it appearing that due notice of the Motion has been provided; and it appearing that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion and the hearing, establish just cause for the relief granted herein, and after due deliberation, it is hereby

#### ORDERED as follows:

1. Bernard Berk is hereby vested with the sole and exclusive authority to manage the Debtor in all respects, including without limitation (a) to approve all budgets and disbursements of funds (in each case in consultation with Citizens), (b) to take any and all actions necessary and appropriate to consummate the sales approved by Court prior to and after the date hereof, and (c) to direct all employees, officers, directors, agents

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and representatives of the Debtor, including counsel and Raymond James & Associates, Inc.

- 2. Any officer, director, employee, agent and/or representative of the Debtor, including counsel for the Debtor and Raymond James & Associates, Inc. and those with authority to write checks or otherwise disburse the Debtor's funds, shall only take direction from the Designated Officer, Mr. Berk, and shall not take direction from Nirmal Mulye or any other person.
- 3. Nirmal Mulye is hereby ordered and directed: (a) to cease exercising managerial control over the Debtor, (b) to cease directing employees, officers, directors, agents and representatives of the Debtor, including counsel and Raymond James & Associates, Inc., (c) to cease any control over any of the Debtor's finances, including to cease authorizing any disbursements or any payments.
- 4. Nirmal Mulye, in his personal capacity and in his capacity as sole representative of Enem Nostrum Remedies Pvt., Ltd, is hereby ordered and directed to cooperate in all respects with the Designated Officer, counsel for the Debtor and Raymond James & Associates, Inc., including without limitation in connection with consummating the sales of the Debtor's assets and surrendering any property of the estate to purchasers therefor.
- Nirmal Mulye is hereby directed not to interfere with the Debtor's operations, finances, management and/or sale process.
