Dear Ms. Tran:

Our firm represents Allen D. Applbaum as Receiver in the referenced District of Arizona matter pursuant to that certain *Order Appointing Receiver, Freezing Assets and Imposing Litigation Injunction* [ECF No. 154] (the "Order") and Temporary Restraining Order [ECF No. 78] (the "TRO").

The United States District Court for the District of Arizona entered the Order and TRO to protect investors and other parties in investment funds and assets owned and/or controlled by one or more of Defendants Jonathan M. Larmore, ArciTerra Companies, LLC, ArciTerra Note Advisors II, LLC, ArciTerra Note Advisors III, LLC, ArciTerra Strategic Retail Advisors, LLC, and Cole Capital Funds, LLC as well as other entities identified in the Order (collectively the "Receivership Entities").

Having become aware of a nexus between Mr. Larmore and WeWork, on March 12, 2024, the Receiver filed a claim in an unliquidated amount on account of any and all claims belonging to the Receivership Entities, Claim No 11087 (the "Claim"). A copy of the Claim is enclosed. The Claim was designated Claim No. 11087. On December 23, 2024, the UCC Settlement Trust Trustee filed the WeWork UCC Settlement Trust Trustee's First Omnibus Objection to Certain General Unsecured Claims objecting to the Claim (Docket No. 2374).

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Since the filing of the Claim, and the objection thereto, the Receiver continued to conduct diligence to determine whether the ArciTerra Receivership Entities had cognizable claims against the WeWork estates. The Receiver has determined to withdraw the Claim. Therefore, the Receiver requests that Epiq record the Claim as withdrawn.
