**PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMANTS' OBJECTION TO THE DEBTORS'
MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER (I) APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING
MANDATORY UNLIQUIDATED CLAIM PROCEDURES TO RESOLVE
PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY AND GENERAL LIABILITY CLAIMS;
(II) REQUIRING THE DEBTORS' INSURERS TO SATISFY THEIR
OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE APPLICABLE POLICIES;
AND (III) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF**

The Estate of Charles Katan, Kenneth Enriquez Jr., individually and as personal representative of the Estate of Kenneth Enriquez, Della Lobato, individually and as personal representative of the Estate of Adam Raul Lobato, Michael Lobato, Jennifer Martinez, individually and as personal representative of the Estate of Arthur Henniges,

Tammy Scouten, individually and as personal representative of the Estate of Robert Scouten, Lisa Encinias, and Robin Gentry, individually and as personal representative of the Estate of Jerry Gentry (collectively, “Personal Injury Claimants”) by and through undersigned counsel, file this objection (“Objection”) to the *Debtors’ Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Approving and Authorizing Mandatory Unliquidated Claim Procedures to Resolve Professional Liability and General Liability Claims; (II) Requiring the Debtors’ Insurers to Satisfy Their Obligations Under the Applicable Policies; and (III) Granting Related Relief* [Dkt. 1201] (“Motion”), and respectfully state as follows:

BACKGROUND

1. The Personal Injury Claimants are comprised of tort plaintiffs in varying stages of pre-litigation and/or pending litigation in Connecticut and New Mexico state courts (the “State Court Cases”) against certain Debtors and/or non-debtor defendants. Their claims are unliquidated.

2. On July 9, 2025, Genesis Healthcare Inc. and its debtor affiliates (collectively, the “Debtors”) filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Texas (the “Court”). These cases are jointly administered in the above-captioned case.

3. On September 4, 2025, the Debtors filed a motion seeking to extend the automatic stay under 11 U.S.C. § 362 to certain non-debtors, which the Court granted on October 14, 2025 [Dkt. 1269] (the “Stay Order”). The automatic stay and the Stay Order enjoin the continuation of any lawsuits against the Debtors and applicable non-debtor defendants during the pendency of these chapter 11 cases. *See Stay Order.*

4. On October 7, 2025, the Debtors filed the Motion seeking approval of a set of mandatory interim procedures for resolving personal injury and professional liability

claims (“Unliquidated Claim Procedures”) prior to confirmation of any chapter 11 plan. These procedures are allegedly voluntary at this time. Motion, Ex. 1, ¶ 13. However, the Unliquidated Claim Procedures indicate that such procedures will become binding under a future Chapter 11 plan, effectively previewing plan-related treatment without the procedural safeguards of plan confirmation. *See id.* And if initiated, the only means by which to terminate the Unliquidated Claim Procedures is subject to Debtors’ consent and contingent on a claimant’s agreement to waive any right to recovery against the estates and any party who may seek reimbursement from the estates for such claims other than insurance proceeds, if any, *and* that no discovery or other burden will be required of the Debtors or their employees or representatives. *See* Motion, Ex. 1, ¶ 19.

5. At the same time, Debtors acknowledge that certain deductible and self-insured retention obligations may reduce or eliminate insurance coverage. *See* Motion, ¶ 23-28. These procedures impermissibly seek to modify contractual obligations among insurers, the Debtors, and claimants before confirmation and potentially risks the availability of insurance coverage intended to satisfy these claims. *See* Motion, Ex. 1, ¶ 19.

6. Regardless of consent, these Unliquidated Claim Procedures enjoin claimants from taking any actions to liquidate their claims against Debtors and other non-debtor defendants, including, without limitation, filing or continuing any litigation or seeking relief from the automatic stay, other than through these Unliquidated Claim Procedures. *See* Motion, Ex. 1, ¶¶ 9-12. The only means with which to lift the Unliquidated Claim Procedure Injunction is to resolve the claim or complete the Unliquidated Claim Procedures. *See id.*

7. Completion of the Unliquidated Claim Procedures requires each claimant to participate in certain offer and exchange procedures with strict deadlines that permit

the Debtors to label non-responsive claimants as acting in bad faith—laying the foundation for sanctions and disallowance. Motion, Ex. 1, ¶¶ 20-32.

8. For claims not resolved through the offer-and-exchange stage, the Unliquidated Claim Procedures require claimants to submit to mandatory non-binding mediation before a mediator selected by the Debtors from a court-approved panel. Motion, Ex. 1, ¶¶ 33-35. Mediation costs must be shared equally by the participants and if any claimant or representative of the Debtors fails to appear without providing adequate notice, that party is responsible for one hundred percent of the mediation costs. Motion, Ex. 1, § V. These provisions impose direct financial obligations on tort claimants and penalize those unable to pay.

9. The Unliquidated Claim Procedures further provide that any settlement reached through the Unliquidated Claim Procedures shall be binding on Debtors and the Holders of the Unliquidated Claims without further order of the Court and shall constitute a final and Allowed Claim for all purposes. Motion, Ex. 1, ¶¶ 40-43. These provisions evade notice requirements under Rule 9019 for settlements under \$1 million.

10. The Unliquidated Claim Procedures authorize the Debtors to seek sanctions and disallowance if a claimant fails to comply with the procedures, to negotiate in good faith, or to cooperate as may be necessary to effectuate the Unliquidated Claim Procedures. *See* Motion, Ex. 1, § IX. These provisions vest Debtors with discretion to challenge and expunge tort claims outside the Bankruptcy Rule 3007 objection process.

11. Finally, under the Unliquidated Claim Procedures, the Court would retain exclusive jurisdiction to resolve any dispute arising under or in connection with these Procedures or any insurance policy providing coverage for the Claims. This retention

clause extends the Court's authority to coverage disputes among non-debtor insurers and claimants. Motion, Ex. 1, § VI.

12. Even if claimants complete the Unliquidated Claim Procedures, their rights to adjudicate their claims by jury trial outside the bankruptcy case are not preserved. Instead, Debtors require claimants to initiate new proceedings to determine whether the Court has jurisdiction, whether abstention applies, and whether the claim should be estimated for allowance or disallowance. Motion, Ex. 1, ¶¶ 45-49. If the Court determines it lacks or declines jurisdiction, the Debtors further seek to dictate the forum in which those claims must be adjudicated. The Personal Injury Claimants expressly reserve their rights to adjudicate their claims outside the bankruptcy case and preserve all venue arguments, including the right to have their state-law claims tried in the jurisdictions where the underlying conduct occurred.

13. Each of these provisions, individually and collectively, prematurely seek to centralize the liquidation of personal injury claims inside the bankruptcy case, to shift costs and procedural burdens onto tort victims, and to limit or preclude the adjudication of debtor and non-debtor liability.

ARGUMENT

14. The Motion is premature and unnecessary at this time, and should be denied or, at a minimum, deferred until plan confirmation. The protections the Debtors seek already exist. The automatic stay under 11 U.S.C. § 362 prohibits the continuation of any litigation against the Debtors, and the Stay Order extends that protection to certain non-debtor defendants. Bankruptcy Rule 9019 permits settlements of claims with notice and court approval. Together, these existing protections accomplish precisely what the Debtors' proposed Unliquidated Claim Procedures purport to achieve—pausing the

litigation of tort claims during the pendency of these cases while allowing resolution through settlement where appropriate. There is no demonstrated need for additional procedures at this stage.

15. Even if additional procedures were warranted, the framework proposed by the Debtors is improper in both substance and scope. The Unliquidated Claim Procedures would displace statutory safeguards and established procedures with a bespoke framework that restricts claimants' substantive rights, circumvents Rule 9019 review, and imposes premature settlement mechanics. Procedures for the liquidation of personal injury claims should be addressed only through a confirmed plan, where classification, funding, and insurance coverage can be properly defined and considered. Implementing them now adds unnecessary administrative burden, invites confusion, and risks direct conflict with future plan provisions governing the classification, funding, and treatment of personal-injury claims. In reality, the likelihood of any claims being resolved under these procedures before plan confirmation is minimal.

16. Nevertheless, to the extent the Court considers approval of any portion of the proposed Unliquidated Claim Procedures, the Personal Injury Claimants identify and preserve the following rights and objections. These issues are raised to ensure that, if the Unliquidated Claim Procedures are implemented in any form, the Personal Injury Claimants' statutory, procedural, and constitutional rights are not impaired.

17. To the extent the Unliquidated Claim Procedures seek to centralize the liquidation or adjudication of personal-injury claims before this Court, the Personal Injury Claimants preserve their rights under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157(b)(2)(B) and (b)(5) to liquidate their claims outside the Bankruptcy Case.

18. To the extent the Unliquidated Claim Procedures interfere with or condition the right to a jury trial, the Personal Injury Claimants preserve all rights under 28 U.S.C. § 1411 and the Seventh Amendment to have their claims adjudicated to final judgment by jury.

19. To the extent the Unliquidated Claim Procedures compel the waiver of claims against the Debtors' estates or claims against any party who may seek reimbursement from the estates for such claims, the Personal Injury Claimants object and preserve all rights and claims.

20. To the extent the Unliquidated Claim Procedures seek to limit the Personal Injury Claimants' rights to collect against applicable insurance policies, the Personal Injury Claimants object and preserve all rights under applicable non-bankruptcy law and governing insurance contracts.

21. To the extent the Unliquidated Claim Procedures seek to modify contractual obligations under applicable insurance policies, the Personal Injury Claimants object and preserve all rights of enforcement against insurers.

22. To the extent the Unliquidated Claim Procedures require claimants to initiate new proceedings in this Court to determine jurisdiction, abstention, or estimation, or authorize the Debtors to dictate the forum in which such claims must be heard, the Personal Injury Claimants object and preserve all venue, abstention, and withdrawal-of-reference rights and arguments.

23. To the extent the Procedures empower the Debtors to disallow, expunge, or sanction claims based on undefined "good-faith" standards or procedural deadlines, the Personal Injury Claimants preserve their rights under Bankruptcy Rule 3007 and the Due

Process Clause to receive notice and a hearing before any claim is reduced, modified, or disallowed.

24. The Personal Injury Claimants further reserve all other substantive and procedural rights not expressly addressed herein, including their rights to object to any plan, settlement, or modification of insurance coverage that may affect their claims.

25. The Personal Injury Claimants expressly incorporate by reference any and all objections filed against the Motion to the extent applicable to their claims and interests. The Personal Injury Claimants further reserve all rights to supplement or amend this Objection, seek discovery, and raise additional arguments at or before any hearing on the Motion.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the Personal Injury Claimants respectfully request that the Court deny the Motion as premature or, alternatively, defer consideration until plan confirmation, and grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
