ORDER ESTABLISHING CONFIDENTIALITY PROCEDURES FOR SURVIVORS' LETTERS FILED ON THE COURT DOCKET

This matter is before the Court on the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors' Motion to Establish Confidentiality Procedures for Survivors' Letters Filed on the Court Docket (the "Motion"). Based on the Motion, and the records, filings, and proceedings in this case, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The Motion is Granted as follows:
- 2. Upon the Court's receipt of a Letter from a Survivor, the clerk of court or the appropriate designee will enter the letter under seal on the docket in this case, unless the authoring Survivor has unambiguously expressed his or her affirmative consent to publication of the Letter.
- 3. The clerk of court or the appropriate designee shall transmit a copy of the Letter to counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors.

4. Parties who have not signed the Confidentiality Agreement provided as Exhibit 4

to this Court's Order (I) Establishing Deadlines For Filing Proofs Of Claim; (II) Approving Sexual

Abuse Claim Supplement; (III) Approving Form And Manner Of Notice; And (IV) Approving

Confidentiality Procedures, Dkt. 316, are prohibited from accessing any sealed Letter.

5. Upon the Court's receipt of a Letter from a Survivor, Counsel for the Official

Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") is directed to distribute the unredacted

Letter among Permitted Parties who have signed the Confidentiality Agreement and requested in

writing copies of a filed Letter.

6. Counsel for the Committee is directed to post the above procedures on the website

the Committee maintains at www.baltimoresurvivors.com and to use reasonable efforts to

communicate these procedures to pro se claimant.
