**STIPULATION AND AGREED ORDER BETWEEN REORGANIZED DEBTORS AND
FOUR P FAMILY HOLDINGS, LP AND BYRD FAMILY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP**

The above-captioned reorganized debtors (before the Effective Date of the Plan, the “Debtors” and after the Effective Date of the Plan, the “Reorganized Debtors”), Four P Family Holdings, LP, and Byrd Family Limited Partnership (collectively, the “Claimants,” and together with the Reorganized Debtors, the “Parties”) enter this stipulation and agreed order (the “Stipulation”) as follows:

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2020 (the “Petition Date”), the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “Bankruptcy Court”);

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2021 the Bankruptcy Court entered an order [Docket No. 2915]² (the “Confirmation Order”) confirming the Debtors’ *Fifth Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan*

of Reorganization [Docket No. 2833] (as the same may have been modified, supplemented, and amended, and including all supplements and exhibits thereto, the “Plan”);³

WHEREAS, the Plan became effective on February 9, 2021 (the “Effective Date”);

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2021, Claimants filed *Four P Family Holdings, LP’s and Byrd Family Limited Partnership’s Application for Allowance and Payment of Administrative Claims Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 503(A)* [Docket No. 3944] (the “Administrative Claim”);

WHEREAS, the Parties have consensually agreed, after good faith, arm’s-length negotiations, to resolve the Administrative Claim pursuant to the terms herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals, which are incorporated into this Stipulation, the Parties hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The Administrative Claim is allowed in the amount of \$5,000 for Four P Family Holdings, LP and \$5,000 for Byrd Family Limited Partnership, for a total amount of \$10,000.
2. Upon entry of this Stipulation, Epiq Corporate Restructuring, LLC is authorized to update the Official Claims Register to reflect the terms herein.
3. The entry of this Stipulation and the treatment herein fully and finally resolves the Administrative Claim. The Claimants, for themselves and all that may claim through them, release all claims and/or purported claims against Debtors and Reorganized Debtors that arose prior to the Effective Date of the Plan, including without limitation, those asserted in any proof of claim or administrative claim filed by or on behalf of the Claimants.
4. The Reorganized Debtor are directed to pay the allowed Administrative Claims in the amount of \$5,000 for Four P Family Holdings, LP and \$5,000 for Byrd Family Limited Partnership, for a total amount of \$10,000, on or before the 15th day after either (a) the filing of

this Stipulation or (b) a completed Form W-9 is provided to the Reorganized Debtors, whichever is later.

5. The Parties hereby agree that each party shall bear its own costs and attorneys' fees and other expenses incurred related to the Administrative Claim and this Stipulation.

6. Neither this Stipulation nor any negotiations and writings in connection with this Stipulation are intended to, or shall be construed to: (a) be evidence of or an admission on behalf of either Party regarding any claim, right or defense that such Party may have against the other Party; or (b) waive or otherwise modify any releases, exculpation, injunction, and discharge provided in the Plan or by operation of the Bankruptcy Code, except as explicitly provided herein.

7. This Stipulation is immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.


8. The Stipulation is intended by the Parties to be binding upon their successors, agents, assigns, and any parent, subsidiary, or affiliated entity of the Parties.

9. The signatories to this Stipulation represent and warrant they have full authority to execute this Stipulation on behalf of the respective Parties and that the respective Parties have full knowledge of, and have consented to, this Stipulation. Claimant represents that it has not sold, pledged, conveyed, assigned, or otherwise transferred any part of the Administrative Claim or any right, interest, or cause of action it may have against the Reorganized Debtors related to the Administrative Claim.

10. This Stipulation shall not be modified, altered, amended, or supplemented except by a writing executed by the Parties.

11. The Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the interpretation, implementation or enforcement of this Stipulation.
