**ORDER SUSTAINING THE DEBTORS' THIRD  
OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CERTAIN PROOFS OF CLAIM  
(NO LIABILITY CLAIMS; RECLASSIFIED CLAIMS; AND REDUCED CLAIMS)**

Upon the *Debtors' Third Omnibus Objection to Certain Proofs of Claim (No Liability Claims; Reclassified Claims; and Reduced Claims)* (the "Objection")<sup>2</sup> of the above-captioned reorganized debtors (collectively, the "Reorganized Debtors") for entry of an order (this "Order") authorizing the Reorganized Debtors to disallow or modify, as applicable, the No Liability Claims identified on **Schedule 1** attached hereto; the Reclassified Claims identified on **Schedule 2** attached hereto; and the Reduced Claims identified on **Schedule 3** attached hereto, all as more fully set forth in the Objection; and upon the First Day Declaration; and this Court having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Order of Reference to Bankruptcy Judges* from the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas, entered May 24, 2012; and this Court having found that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and this Court having found that it may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; and this Court having found that venue of this

proceeding and the Objection in this district is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and this Court having found that the relief requested in the Objection is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors' estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and this Court having found that the Reorganized Debtors' notice of the Objection and opportunity for a hearing on the Objection were appropriate and no other notice need be provided; and this Court having reviewed the Objection and having heard the statements in support of the relief requested therein at a hearing before this Court (the "Hearing"), if any; and this Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection and at the Hearing, if any, establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and upon all of the proceedings had before this Court; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is **HEREBY ORDERED THAT**:

1. Any responses to the Objection not otherwise withdrawn, resolved, or adjourned are overruled on the merits.

2. Each No Liability Claim identified on **Schedule 1** attached to this Order is modified in its entirety for all purposes in the chapter 11 cases and shall be expunged from the claims register. The claims listed in the column titled "Surviving Claims" on **Schedule 1** shall remain on the Reorganized Debtors' claims register, subject to the Reorganized Debtors' further objections on any substantive or non-substantive grounds and further order of the Court.

3. Each Reclassified Claim identified on **Schedule 2** attached to this Order is reclassified in its entirety for all purposes in the chapter 11 cases and shall be expunged from the claims register. The claims listed in the column titled "Modified" on **Schedule 2** shall remain on the Reorganized Debtors' claims register, subject to the Reorganized Debtors' further objections on any substantive or non-substantive grounds and further order of the Court.

4. Each Reduced Claim identified on Schedule 3 attached to this Order is disallowed in its entirety for all purposes in the chapter 11 cases and shall be expunged from the claims register. The claims listed in the column titled “Modified” on Schedule 3 shall remain on the Reorganized Debtors’ claims register, subject to the Reorganized Debtors’ further objections on any substantive or non-substantive grounds and further order of the Court.

5. The hearing on the Objection, solely as it relates to the Claims identified on Schedule 4 (the “Adjourned Claims”), is adjourned for thirty (30) days, subject to the Court’s availability. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Order, all rights and arguments the holders of the Adjourned Claims have in respect of the Objection are preserved. The deadline for the holders of Adjourned Claims to file any opposition to the Objection will be three (3) days before the new hearing date on the Objection (subject to the right of the Reorganized Debtors and the holders of Adjourned Claims to agree to extensions of such deadline).

6. The Reorganized Debtors’ claims, noticing, and solicitation agent, Epiq Corporate Restructuring LLC, and the clerk of this Court, as applicable, are authorized and directed to update the claims register maintained in these chapter 11 cases to reflect the relief granted in this Order.

7. This Order will be deemed a separate order with respect to each Objected Claim.

8. Notwithstanding the relief granted in this Order and any actions taken pursuant to such relief, nothing in this Order shall be deemed: (a) an admission as to the validity of any claim against any of the Debtors or Reorganized Debtors; (b) a waiver of the Reorganized Debtors’ right to dispute any prepetition claim on any grounds; (c) a promise or requirement to pay any claim; (d) an implication or admission that any particular claim is of a type specified or defined in this Objection or any order granting the relief requested by this Objection; (e) a request or authorization to assume any prepetition agreement, contract, or lease pursuant to section 365 of the Bankruptcy

Code; or (f) a waiver of the Debtors' rights under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable law.



10. The terms and conditions of this Order are immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

11. The Reorganized Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted in this Order in accordance with the Objection.

12. This Court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
