

Upon consideration of the *Reorganized Debtors' Eighth Omnibus Objection to Certain Administrative, Secured, and Priority Claims* (the "Objection")<sup>1</sup> on behalf of above-captioned reorganized debtors (the "Reorganized Debtors"), and the Court having jurisdiction over this core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and venue of this matter in the District of New Jersey being proper under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and the Court having reviewed the Objection, the Claims listed on Schedule 1 hereto, any responses to the Objection, and any replies to those responses; and due notice of the Objection having been provided; and it appearing that no other or further notice of the Objection need be provided; and the Court having found and determined that the relief sought in the Objection and granted herein is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors, their estate and creditors, and all parties in interest, and that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Objection is **GRANTED** as forth herein.
2. Each No Liability Claim listed on Schedule 1 hereto is hereby disallowed.
3. The Reorganized Debtors are authorized to take any action necessary or appropriate to give effect to this Order and the relief granted therein.

4. Epiq Corporate Restructuring, LLC, the Court-appointed claims agent in the Chapter 11 Case, is hereby authorized and directed to make such revisions to the official claims register as are necessary to reflect the relief granted in this Order.

5. The Reorganized Debtors, their estates, the GUC Trustee, any successors thereto, and any other party in interest shall retain and shall have the right to object in the future to any of the Claims listed on Schedule 1 on any additional grounds, and the Reorganized Debtors shall retain and shall have the right to amend, modify and/or supplement the Objection as may be necessary.

6. The Reorganized Debtors' objection to each Claim addressed in the Objection constitutes a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rule 9014. This Order shall be deemed a separate order with respect to each Claim. Any stay of this Order pending appeal by any of the claimants subject to this Order shall only apply to the contested matter which involves such claimant and shall not act to stay the applicability and/or finality of this Order with respect to the other contested matters covered hereby.

7. This Order is without prejudice rights of the Reorganized Debtors, the Reorganized Debtors' estates, the GUC Trustee, any successors thereto, and any other party in interest to object to any other claim filed in the Chapter 11 Cases.

8. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over the claimants whose claims are subject to the Objection with respect to any matter arising from or related to the Objection or this Order, including the interpretation, enforcement and implementation of the Order.
