NOTICE OF CLOSING OF AT&T TRANSACTIONS AND FUNDING OF FCC TRUST

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on July 28, 2026, EchoStar Corporation (“**EchoStar**” or the “**Seller**”), the indirect parent company of the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases, and the other Seller Parties identified in the License Purchase Agreement (together with the Seller, the “**Seller Parties**”), completed the closing (the “**Closing**”) the transactions (the “**Transactions**”) contemplated by the License Purchase Agreement, dated August 25, 2025 (the “**License Purchase Agreement**”), between the Seller Parties and AT&T Mobility II LLC (the “**Buyer**”), a subsidiary of AT&T Inc.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to the License Purchase Agreement, at the Closing, the Seller Parties sold all 3.45 GHz and 600 MHz spectrum licenses held by the Seller Parties (collectively, the “**Licenses**”) and entered into a 99-year extension of existing leases for the Buyer’s exclusive use of certain wireless spectrum licenses in Hawaii. At the Closing, EchoStar received proceeds of \$20,250,000,000. Separately, as a condition of the Federal Communications Commission’s approval of the assignment of the Licenses—as set forth in the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau’s Memorandum Opinion and Orders, DA 26-470 and DA 26-471, dated May 12, 2026—the Buyer deposited an additional \$2,400,000,000 into the “Wireless Creditor Trust” (the “**FCC Trust**”) established pursuant to the Trust Agreement, dated June 26, 2026, between EchoStar (on behalf of itself and its subsidiaries and affiliates) and The Bank of New York Mellon, as trustee (the “**FCC Trust Agreement**”).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, of the \$2,400,000,000 deposited into the FCC Trust, \$200,000,000 was set aside in a segregated reserve account for the benefit of “Type A Claims” (claims of \$100,000 or less).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in connection with the Closing, all amounts outstanding under the Loan and Security Agreement, dated November 26, 2021, between Debtor DISH DBS Corporation, as lender, and DISH Network Corporation, as borrower, were satisfied in

full. Additionally, the approximately \$3,686,000,000 outstanding (inclusive of early redemption premium and accrued but unpaid interest) under the 11 3/4% Senior Secured Notes due November 15, 2027, issued pursuant to the Secured Indenture, dated November 15, 2022, by and among DISH Network Corporation, the guarantors identified therein, and U.S. Bank Trust Company, National Association, as trustee and collateral agent, was redeemed in full at the Closing.²
